The Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (DNR) has reviewed the route permit application for a Route Permit to Rebuild the Existing 69kV ST-WW Transmission Line to 115kV in Stearns County. Our agency offers the following comments:

Limited early coordination with the DNR has occurred on this transmission line rebuild project. Typically, the project proposer works with our agency's Regional Environmental Assessment Ecologist to identify potential natural resource impacts prior to submitting a permit application to the Public Utilities Commission. The Draft Natural Heritage Review, provided in Appendix E, may <u>not</u> be used to meet the requirements for permitting, licensing, or formal environmental review. Further route details are necessary for the DNR to fully analyze potential natural resource impacts. Additional information, such as pole placement, will allow our agency to provide feedback on any route alternatives and to recommend permit conditions prior to permit approval.
