Acting Executive Secretary Bull,

Clean Energy Economy Minnesota (CEEM), the Coalition for Community Solar Access (CCSA) and the Minnesota Solar Energy Industries Association (MnSEIA) - collectively the Clean Energy Organizations (CEOs) hereby submit an additional decision option for the August 14th, 2025 agenda meeting on Docket E999/CI-16-521 –In the Matter of Updating the Generic Standards for the Interconnection and Operation of Distributed Generation Facilities Established Under Minn. Stat. § 216B.1611 (Regarding the Xcel Internal Transmission Study (ITS)). Decision Option 2 as written, in combination with other decision options, remains the CEO's preference. This modification is offered only as an alternative should the existing DO 2 not be adopted.

If DO 2 as written is not adopted, the CEOs offer CEOs Modified 2:

CEOs Modified 2: Order Xcel to stay the ITS process through January 1, 2026.
