

Notice of Amended Environmental Assessment Scoping Decision

In the Matter of the Joint Application of Summit Lake Solar, LLC and Summit Lake Storage, LLC, for Site Permits for the 200 MW Solar Energy Generating System and 200 MW Battery Energy Storage System for the Summit Lake Project in Nobles County, Minnesota

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) has issued an amended scoping decision for the environmental assessment (EA) that will be prepared for the proposed Summit Lake Project in Nobles County, Minnesota. The amended scoping decision reflects changes to the project layout proposed by Summit Lake Solar, LLC and Summit Lake Storage, LLC in their application amendment of December 18, 2025.

The EA will be prepared by the Commission's Energy Infrastructure Permitting (EIP) staff and will address the potential human and environmental impacts of the project. The amended scoping decision identifies those issues that will be studied, as well as those that will not be addressed.
