In the Matter of the Application of Great River Energy and Minnesota Power for a Certificate of Need for the Motley Area 115 kV Transmission Line Project in Morrison, Cass and Todd Counties, Minnesota

Topic/s Open for Comment:

• Should the Commission grant Great River Energy and Minnesota Power's exemption requests?

Project Background: On October 30, 2014, Great River Energy and Minnesota Power requested an exemption from certain filing requirements under Minn. Rules, parts 7849.0260, 7849.0270, 7849.0280, 7849.0290 and 7849.0300. The Motley Area Project is a proposal to construct approximately 14 miles of new 115 kV transmission line and to construct/modify substations in the Motley area.

Note: Staff will propose to the Commission that the deadline for action on the exemption request as required under Minn. Rules 7849.0200 subd. 6 be extended to coincide with the comment deadlines noted above.
