PETITION

INTRODUCTION

Northern States Power Company, doing business as Xcel Energy (Company), submits this Petition for approval of tariff modifications related to enrollment in the electric space heating rate options under our residential rate tariffs. This Petition is presented in Compliance with Order Point No. 8 of the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission's (Commission) February 23, 2026 ORDER APPROVING TARIFF MODIFICATIONS, APPROVING COMPLIANCE PLAN, AND SETTING ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR RESIDENTIAL TIME-OF-USE RATE IMPLEMENTATION in the above-referenced docket.

Order Point No. 8 of the Commission's February 23, 2026 Order states that:

Xcel must draft tariff language to allow enrollment in the electric space heating rate through the heat pump rebate application and self-enrollment and file the proposed language in this docket within 30 days of this Order.

The Company respectfully requests Commission approval to add language to our standard Residential,¹ Residential Time-of-Day (TOD),² and Residential Time-of-Use (TOU) Service³ tariffs highlighting the available options for customers interested in enrolling in the electric space heating rates. In addition to these modifications related

to space heating rate enrollment, the Company also requests approval of a modification to the terms and conditions of service intended to prevent customers from avoiding the price signals of the rate by opting-in and opting-out of the rate in a short period of time.

PETITION

I. TARIFF MODIFICATION DETAILS

A. Space Heating Rate Enrollment Modification

The Company offers an electric space heating rate for customers with electric space heating equipment used as their primary heating source.⁴ The rate is available to customers who are on the standard Residential rate, two-period Residential TOD rate, or those who choose to take service on the recently approved three-period Residential TOU rate.

Currently these tariffs do not spell out how customers can enroll in the electric space heating rate. In compliance with the Commission's Order, the Company requests Commission approval to modify the Residential, Residential TOD, and Residential TOU Service tariffs by adding the following language:

Customers using electric space heating equipment as their primary heating source are eligible for the electric space heating rate option. Eligible customers may enroll in the electric space heating rate option by contacting the Company via phone. Customers applying for a heat pump rebate from the Company for equipment that will serve as a primary heating source may enroll in the electric space heating rate through the rebate application.

The enrollment process will be the same for customers regardless of their residential service option, so the same language can be applied to each tariff.

The proposed tariff modifications would be applied to three pages of our Minnesota Electric Rate Book—Section No. 5, Sheet Nos. 1, 2, and 4.1. Attachment A to this Petition includes a redlined and clean version of the modified tariff pages.

B. Terms and Conditions of Service Modification

The Company also requests approval to modify the terms and conditions of service shown in the tariff. Specifically, the currently approved tariff lists the following under the terms and conditions of service:

Any customer who opts-out of this rate cannot reenroll in the rate for a minimum of 12 months from the end of the last billing cycle on the rate.

This language is intended to prevent customers from avoiding the price signals of the rate by opting-in to the rate when the pricing is advantageous to their energy usage and later opting-out when it is not. This is an important goal but, upon further review, the Company is concerned that as currently written it may drive customers from the rate permanently rather than encouraging long-term participation, e.g., that after the required “lock out” period ends, customers may forget or may not be inclined to reconsider the rate. As such the Company respectfully requests to replace the tariff language above with the following language:

Any customer who has previously taken service under this tariff and opted out is required to stay on this rate for a minimum of 12 months if they wish to reenroll.

This new language will still meet the goal of preventing customers from using the rate only when it is advantageous but would do so without locking customers out of the rate for an extended period. This proposed tariff modification would be applied to Section No. 5, Sheet No. 4.2 of our Minnesota Electric Rate Book. The redlined and clean version of the modified tariff pages are included in Attachment A.

CONCLUSION

The Company appreciates the Commission’s consideration of the tariff modifications proposed in this Petition. The requested modifications will add language to three residential service tariffs noting the enrollment options for the electric space heating rate as well as modify the terms and conditions of service for our Residential TOU Rate.
