In the Matter of a Commission Inquiry into Ownership of Renewable Energy Credits used to Meet Minnesota Requirements

• Who owns the RECs from net metered customers? Does it matter if the QF is being paid the average retail rate or avoided cost rate?

Sundial agrees with the Department of Commerce and ELPC that the renewable generator (or the generator's assignee) should own the RECs generated by the system.

• Who owns the RECs if a third party owns the PV system and leases to the business?

Only the owner/generator of the renewable power should own the RECs and be free to do with the RECs as it chooses.

• What factors should the Commission take into account when determining REC ownership?

The only factor that should be considered is who owns or leases the generating system.
