Re: Notice of Minnesota Public Utilities Commission Proceeding
MPUC Docket No: E290,E142/SA-19-187

As you may know, Owatonna Public Utilities (OPU) has reached an agreement with Steele-Waseca Cooperative Electric in which OPU will provide electric service to certain customers within the City of Owatonna, including your property. The timing of any transfer of electric service will be spelled out in greater detail as we get closer to that date. We currently project the transfer to occur in Summer 2019. Both utilities seek to make a smooth transition, with minimal disruption to customers.

In the meantime, to reflect the change in assigned electric service territory, the utilities have sought to update the maps on file with the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (MPUC). The MPUC is a state agency with jurisdiction over electric service territory boundaries. The MPUC requires notice to customers located in an area involved in a change in the service territory maps. This letter provides that formal notice.


