# Statement Providing Justification for Trade Secret Information

Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) is providing a non-public version of ab amendment to a contract regarding its Receivable Sales Program in the above captioned docket.

The non-public version of the filing contains trade secret information, as defined by section 13.37 subd. 1(b), of the Minnesota Statutes, in that the amendment to the contract is subject to efforts by IPL and other parties that are reasonable under the circumstances to maintain its non-disclosure, and derives independent economic value, actual or potential from not being generally known to, and being readily ascertainable by proper means by, other person who can obtain economic value from its disclosure or use. While certain related agreements have been previously publicly available, this amendment has not. Additionally, the amendment and related contracts are subject to certain confidentiality provisions and should be handled accordingly. IPL has marked the information pursuant to the Commission's Revised Procedures for handling Trade Secret and Privileged Data. Minn. Rule, pt. 7829.0500.

IPL respectfully requests that the amendment to the contract be treated as trade secret information. Public release of this information would harm IPL by providing competitors with additional knowledge of the Receivable Sales Program. Those competitors could use this knowledge to improve their negotiating positions in future transactions, to the detriment of IPL or its affiliates. Because disclosure of the information would compromise the ability to negotiate

future contracts on terms and conditions most favorable to it, the harm of public disclosure outweighs the benefits of such disclosure.

Accordingly, IPL believes the marked information contained in IPL's filing meets the definition of trade secret under Minn. Stat. § 13.37.

# SUPPLEMENT TO PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF EXTENSION OF AND MODIFICATION TO AFFILIATED INTEREST AGREEMENTS

On April 29, 2014, Interstate Power and Light Company ("IPL") submitted, pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 216B.48, Minn. R. 7825.2200, and *Order Initiating Repeal of Rule, Granting Generic Variance, and Clarifying Internal Operating Procedures* in Docket No. E,G-999/CI-98-651 (Sept. 14, 1998), Minnesota Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") a petition for approval of an extension and modification to IPL's Receivable Sales Program. IPL's Receivable Sales Program includes contracts among IPL, Alliant Energy Corporation ("AEC"), Alliant Energy Corporate Services, Inc. ("AECS"), IPL SPE LLC ("IPL SPE"), and Alliant Energy SPE LLC ("Alliant SPE") (collectively the "Alliant Energy Companies"). Subsequent to the filing the parties to one of the contracts determined that there was a need for further amendment. This Supplement to the Petition provides updated information in light of that amendment.

On August 22, 2014, the parties to the Amended and Restated Receivables Purchase and Sale Agreement among Alliant SPE, Victory Receivables Corporation ("Victory"), The Bank of Tokyo-Mitsubishi UFJ, Ltd., New York Branch ("BTMU"), and AECS executed Amendment No. 4 to that agreement. Amendment No. 4 is attached as Exhibit 11. That amendment changes the Loss-to-Liquidation ratio limit within the contract.

With the information presented in this Supplement to the Petition, the remainder of the information contained in IPL's original Petition remains accurate. IPL respectfully requests that the Commission consider the amendment and the information in this Supplement as it reviews the petition for approval of an extension and modification to IPL's Receivable Sales Program.

Attached is a verification of this Supplement, which is marked as Exhibit 12.

**WHEREFORE**, IPL respectfully restates its request that the Commission approve the amendments and modifications to the agreement with affiliates related to the Receivable Sales Program.
