As a landowner in SW MN, I have serious concerns about this transmission line being a needed project. We are being inundated with at least 6 different companies and projects in just a few mile radius. National Grid Renewables (formerly Geronimo or Plum Creek Energy) has 2 projects (wind turbines and transmission line, Purple Skies, Invenergy (wouldn't give information of what they want the land for), Box Car and of course, Xcel. This is not including the carbon pipeline which is under 10 miles to the east of these projects. I am concerned with all the land that is temporary home to migratory birds being affected and the fact that land is being taken out of production at a time when we are feeding more and more of the world. Is there not wind closer to Sherburne? Wouldn't it be more efficient and cheaper to put the lines where the power is needed?
