**In the Matter of a Formal Complaint by Larry
Rauenhorst against Renville Sibley

Re: Offer of Settlement

Dear Executive Secretary;

In the interest of attempting to resolve this matter without the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (Commission), Commission Staff, or any other stakeholder having to expend additional time and resources, Larry Rauenhorst, once again, as he has done throughout this dispute, offers to dismiss his complaint with the Commission if Renville Sibley Cooperative Power Association (RSCPA) will agree to interconnect Larry's under 40 kW facility and compensate him at the average retail utility energy rate as required by Minn. Stat. § 216B.164, and RSCPA's own rules, policies and statements. Larry will waive any claims that he has to attorney fees, costs, additional compensation, or any other relief. Continuing this matter through the appellate process will result in considerable time and resources for all involved, which can be avoided by simply complying with the law and RSCPA's own rules, policies and statements.

In the alternative, Larry will agree to engage in mediation as provided for by Minn. Stat. § 216B.164, subd. 11, if RSCPA will agree that, if the mediation does not result in a settlement, the Minnesota District Court will decide the merits of this dispute, including whether Larry is entitled to compensation consistent with Minnesota law.

To accept this Offer of Settlement, RSCPA only has to file in its acceptance in this docket stating whether it will agree to compensate Larry at the rate explicitly provided for by Minnesota law or it prefers to mediate this dispute, with Minnesota District Court deciding the merits of the dispute if a settlement is not reached. If RSCPA files its acceptance of this offer, Larry will file a voluntary dismissal with the Commission.
