I am currently a leaseholder for a MnPower owned property on Whiteface Reservoir. We were recently offered a proposal for land purchase by MN Power. I understand that the approval decision by your commission for this sale was recently tabled, and postponed. I am highly disappointed. I want to make it clear that the recent letter campaign regarding the stoppage of this sale does not represent the majority of leaseholders. This campaign was put forth by a group of highly emotional leaseholders that have no understanding of the process. Others, like myself, understand that MnPower is a "landlord" and that "rent" payment is just that—rent, and not an entitlement to property ownership.

The initial proposal put forth by MnPower, using 2020 assessments + 4% was fair. Many of us would like to obtain our property at that rate, and would like the sale to proceed as soon as possible in order to take advantage of current low interest rates. Your commission's delay is not fair to the majority of those involved.

I request that you add this item to your next meeting, and pass the resolution allowing MnPower to proceed with the leased lot sales on Whiteface.
