Attached are the comments of the Minnesota Department of Commerce (Department) in the following matter:

In the Matter of the Joint Request of Northern State Power Company and Owatonna Public Utilities to Modify Electric Service Territory Boundaries

The Petition was filed by Northern States Power Company, DBA Xcel Energy, on 8/7/2025.

The filing constitutes a joint request on behalf Xcel Energy (Xcel) and Owatonna Public Utilities (OPU), (collectively the Parties) to update the official service territory map to reflect an agreed-upon permanent boundary change affecting one residential and six commercial customers within the city of Owatonna and within the electric service territory assigned to the Xcel Energy. The proposed change, if approved, will transfer electric service territory from Xcel Energy to Owatonna Public Utilities.

The Department recommends the Commission approve the joint request for the agreed-upon permanent boundary change from Xcel Energy to Owatonna Public Utilities and requests MNGEO update the service territory map, to reflect the changes on the map as provided. The Department is available to answer any questions the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission may have.
