The Minnesota Public Utilities Commission’s September 12, 2023 *Order Setting Requirements Related to Inflation Reduction Act* in E,G999/CI-22-624 at point 1 states:

The utilities shall maximize the benefits of the Inflation Reduction Act in future resource acquisitions and requests for proposals in the planning phase, petitions for cost recovery through riders and rate cases, resource plans, gas resource plans, integrated distribution plans, and Natural Gas Innovation Act innovation plans. In such filings, utilities shall discuss how they plan to capture and maximize the benefits from the Act, and how the Act has impacted planning assumptions including (but not limited to) the predicted cost of assets and projects and the adoption rates of electric vehicles, distributed energy resources, and other electrification measures. Reporting shall continue until 2032.

Assuming a transmission line certificate of need is a resource acquisition proceeding, please provide the Applicants response regarding this Commission Order, if any.

Response:

The Applicants do not agree that this transmission line certificate of need proceeding is a resource acquisition proceeding, but acknowledge that certain Applicants may seek to recover the costs associated with construction of the Big Stone South – Alexandria – Big Oaks 345 kV Transmission Project (Project) through a Transmission Cost Recovery Rider, thus relating to a potential future “petition for cost recovery through riders and rate cases.” The Applicants have evaluated the Inflation Reduction Act for applicability to activities to be undertaken in the planning, procurement, and construction of the Project and, at this time, have not identified any opportunities for capturing benefits under the Inflation Reduction Act.

The recently passed Minnesota Statutes § 216B.2422, Subd. 4b states “The commission may give preference in resource selection to projects utilizing energy technologies produced domestically by entities who received an advanced manufacturing tax credit for those technologies under section 45X of the Internal Revenue Code, as allowed under the federal Inflation Reduction Act of 2022, Public Law 117-169.”

Please provide the Applicants response regarding this statutory preference, if any.

Response:

The new statutory language referenced in this Information Request (Minn. Stat. § 216B.2422, subd. 4b) applies to resource selection in integrated resource planning dockets, permitting the Commission to “give preference” to generation resources that received an advanced manufacturing tax credit under section 45X of the Internal Revenue Code. The Big Stone South – Alexandria – Big Oaks 345 kV Transmission Project (Project) involves the construction of new transmission facilities and not new generation resources. Therefore, Minn. Stat. § 216B.2422, subd. 4b does not apply to this proceeding. In addition, section 45X of the Internal Revenue Code applies to the following technologies: photovoltaic cells, wind energy components, torque tubes, structural fasteners, photovoltaic wafers, solar grade polysilicon, polymeric backsheet, solar modules, inverters, electrode active materials, battery cells, battery modules, and applicable critical minerals. None of these materials will be used to construct the Project. That said, the Applicants intend to use domestic suppliers for the materials needed to construct the Project to the extent that domestic suppliers are able to provide the necessary materials on the timeline required to meet the Project’s construction schedule.

Please provide a comparison of the expected reliability of the proposed project to the expected reliability of an alternative consisting of a single-circuit 500 kV line on the Western Segment (Big Stone South to Alexandria), leaving the Eastern Segment as proposed.

Response:

The Long Range Transmission Planning (LRTP) study performed by the Midcontinent Independent System Operator (MISO) did not include any alternatives to the Big Stone South – Alexandria – Big Oaks 345 kV Transmission Project (Project) that involved constructing the Big Stone South – Alexandria line (i.e. Western Segment) at 500 kV. Rather, all the alternatives for the Project considered by MISO were variations of transmission projects that considered different endpoint substations of new double circuit capable 345 kV lines. Therefore, the Applicants provide the following response based on engineering judgment without underlying transmission planning analysis.

Table 5-1 of the Certificate of Need application shows that single circuit 345 kV lines are typically capable of 1792.7 MVA, double circuit 345 kV lines are typically capable of 3585.4 MVA, and single circuit 500 kV lines are typically capable of 2598.1 MVA.<sup>1</sup> However, the thermal capability of a single transmission line is not an accurate reflection of reliability benefits of a single project because the system, as a network of all transmission lines and transformers, must be considered together when evaluating reliability benefits.<sup>2</sup>

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<sup>1</sup> Table 5-1 of the application quantifies the capacity of transmission lines based on an assumed line current of 3000 Amps.

<sup>2</sup> Reliability can be measured in a variety of ways. For purposes of this response, the Applicants assume “reliability” is in reference to maintaining facility loadings within their respective ratings and voltage levels within their respective limits to avoid equipment damage to the system.

The NERC reliability standards require that the transmission system must be able to withstand the loss of a transmission facility and still maintain facility loadings within their respective ratings and voltage levels within their respective limits. In other words, the underlying transmission system must be robust enough to be able to withstand the outage of any other transmission element and still maintain reliability. Without the underlying transmission system having the required capability, the reliability benefits of a single transmission line (or project) will not be realized.

As noted in Chapter 5 of the Certificate of Need application, 345 kV is the standard high voltage that is utilized to transfer large amounts of power long distances in Minnesota because it provides sufficient capacity to accommodate large power transfers and can be easily incorporated into the existing transmission system. Transmission facilities operated at voltages equal to or higher than 500 kV are currently less utilized in Minnesota and are reserved for long distance point-to-point power transfers (e.g., moving power from Manitoba's hydro generation facilities into Minnesota).

Applying this reasoning to the Western Segment of the Project, the reliability benefits of constructing the Western Segment at 500 kV are likely to be limited by the ability of the underlying transmission system to accommodate power transfers when other high voltage transmission facilities experience an outage. To realize the full reliability benefits of constructing the Western Segment at 500 kV, the Applicants believe at least one additional 500 kV line would be needed in the Project area to interconnect along the Western Segment so that at least one 500 kV line is available when the other 500 kV line experiences an outage.

Constructing the Western Segment as a single circuit 500 kV line would also require the installation of new 500/345 kV transformers at the existing Big Stone South and Alexandria substations. A new 500/345 kV transformer, or potentially redundant 500/345 kV transformers, would be needed at each endpoint substation resulting in a much higher substation cost if the Western Segment is constructed at 500 kV.

In addition, constructing the Western Segment as a single circuit 500 kV line also requires consideration of new contingencies (e.g., outages) in system assessments needed for NERC compliance that would not otherwise be possible if the Western Segment is constructed at 345 kV. Depending on the response of the transmission system during a contingency involving these new 500/345 kV transformers or the new 500 kV line, redundant 500/345 kV transformers may be required at the Big Stone South and Alexandria substations in addition to upgrading other existing facilities to ensure the underlying transmission system can withstand the outage of a new 500 kV line or a single transformer and still maintain facility loadings within their respective ratings and voltage levels within their respective limits.

In contrast, having 345 kV facilities already in place at the existing Big Stone South and Alexandria substations make them suitable endpoints for the Western Segment constructed at 345 kV because the substation termination costs for integrating the new 345 kV line will be lower at each substation. Furthermore, MISO has validated through the LRTP Tranche 1 study that constructing the Western Segment at 345 kV is the recommended alternative for the Tranche 1 portfolio. Constructing the Western Segment as a single circuit 500 kV line would require MISO to perform additional transmission planning studies to validate that the LRTP Tranche 1 portfolio performs as intended without introducing additional reliability concerns on the underlying transmission system.

In conclusion, the Applicants have determined through engineering judgment that constructing the Western Segment at 345 kV is the most efficient and cost-effective way to maximize reliability and economic benefits of this Project not only to Minnesota, but the entire MISO Midwest subregion.

Please provide a comparison of the effects upon the natural and socioeconomic environments of the proposed project to the expected effects upon the natural and socioeconomic environments of an alternative consisting of a single-circuit 500 kV line to a double circuit capable 345 kV line along the Western Segment (Big Stone South to Alexandria), leaving the Eastern Segment as proposed.

Response:

A proposed route for the Western Segment is still under development so specific quantifiable impacts based on the proposed route are not yet known. However, Chapter 5 of the Certificate of Need application generally describes the difference between a 345 kV transmission line and 500 kV transmission line. Using this information, the following assumptions were used to perform a qualitative assessment of the expected effects upon the natural and socioeconomic environments of an alternative consisting of a single-circuit 500 kV line and a double-circuit capable 345 kV line along the Western Segment:

<sup>1</sup> The right-of-way needed for the proposed 345 kV line would be approximately 1,820 acres, whereas the area needed for a 500 kV line would be approximately 2,425 acres, a 33% increase in land needed to be put into easement for the construction, operation, and maintenance of the transmission line. Although not quantified in these assumptions, additional property would also be required at the Big Stone South and Alexandria substations if the Western Segment is constructed at 500 kV to accommodate an expansion of the 345 kV switchyard and add enough space for a new 500 kV switchyard at each location that has adequate space for a new 500/345 kV transformer.

Based on these assumptions, the Applicants provide the following qualitative assessment comparing the effects on the natural and socioeconomic environment between a double-circuit capable 345 kV line and a single-circuit 500 kV line for the Western Segment.

- **Aesthetics:** The Western Segment will change the view shed for landowners since it involves the addition of a new transmission line. Although the 345 kV single-pole would be taller, the 500 kV multiple-pole structure would be wider than the 345 kV single-pole structure creating more of a visual impact to the landscape.
- **Agricultural Lands:** The 500 kV multiple-pole structure would create more interference for farm machinery, impact more land than the 345 kV single-pole structure and require a wider right-of-way resulting in a larger impact to agricultural activities as compared to the 345 kV single-pole structure.
- **Airports and Airstrips:** The 345 kV single-pole structures are taller and may require placement further away from airports and airstrips than the shorter, 500 kV multiple-pole structures.
- **Cultural Resources:** The potential for impacting cultural resources is greater for the 500 kV multiple-pole structure versus the 345 kV single-pole structure because there are multiple foundations per structure that create greater land disturbances.
- **Endangered/Threatened and Protected Species:** The potential for impacting individual plants and animals is greater for the 500 kV multiple-pole structure versus the 345 kV single-pole structure because each multiple-pole structure will include two foundations per structure and create greater land disturbances.

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<sup>2</sup> The impact of the 345 kV single-pole structure would be the size of the single foundation (approximately 78 square feet) whereas the impact of the 500 kV multiple-pole structure would be the size of two foundations (approximately 100 square feet), as well as the space created between the poles (approximately 320 square feet), which is four times greater than the single-pole structure.

- **Migratory Birds:** The 345 kV single-pole structure will have more “conductor planes” resulting in a wider “net” of conductors that could increase the chance of migratory bird collisions more than the 500 kV multiple-pole H-Frame structures.<sup>3</sup>
- **Water Resources:** The potential for impacting aquatic resources is greater for the 500 kV multiple-pole structure versus the 345 kV single-pole structure because there are multiple foundations per structure that would create greater land disturbances.
- **Socioeconomics:** The wider right-of-way needed for a 500 kV transmission line could generally result in a greater disproportional affect to the identified environmental justice communities depending on routing, siting, and design/engineering of the proposed Project.

The following table summarizes the qualitative assessment comparing the effects on the natural and socioeconomic environment between a double-circuit capable 345 kV line and a single-circuit 500 kV line for the Western Segment.

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<sup>3</sup> “Conductor planes” refers to the amount of different vertical heights that will be present with each structure type. 345 kV single-pole structures will have four conductor planes (three phases plus shield wire all at different heights above ground) whereas 500 kV multiple-pole H-Frames will have two conductor planes (three phases at similar height with shield wire at a different height above ground).

Please provide a comparison the cost of the proposed project to the cost of an alternative consisting of a single-circuit 500 kV line on the Western Segment (Big Stone South to Alexandria), leaving the Eastern Segment as proposed.

Response:

The Applicants included cost information for a single-circuit 500 kV line compared to a double-circuit 345 kV line in Section 5.1.1.1 of the Certificate of Need application (Application).<sup>1</sup>

Within Section 5.1.1.1, the Applicants stated an indicative cost of \$3.5 million / mile for double-circuit 345 kV line while single-circuit 500 kV line was estimated at \$4.1 million / mile. Assuming a total distance of 100 miles between the Big Stone South Substation and the Alexandria Substation results in an incremental cost of \$60 million if a single-circuit 500 kV line was constructed along the Western Segment rather than a double-circuit 345 kV line.

Furthermore, there are currently no 500 kV facilities located in the Project area. As a result, constructing the Western Segment with a single-circuit 500 kV line would require the installation of new transformers at the existing Big Stone South Substation and the existing Alexandria Substation. At a minimum, a single 500/345 kV transformer would be needed at each of these endpoint substations at an estimated cost of approximately \$20 million per transformer, which does not include the costs associated with expanding these substations to create a 500 kV switchyard and all the associated equipment needed to reliably integrate the new transformers into the

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<sup>1</sup> For purposes of this response, the Applicants compare the cost of the Western Segment being constructed as a double circuit 345 kV line to the Western Segment being constructed as a single circuit 500 kV line. The Applicants expect an even larger difference in cost because they are seeking permission to build the Western Segment as a double circuit capable 345 kV line with one circuit installed initially.

existing substations. The expansion of the Big Stone South and Alexandria substations to create a 500 kV switchyard with adequate room for new 500/345 kV transformers would require purchasing additional land that may not be available immediately adjacent to the existing substation parcels, creating the need to build entirely new substation sites that would need to be electrically connected to the existing substations with multiple 345 kV transmission lines. For purposes of this high-level cost comparison, the Applicants have taken a modest approach based on information contained in the Application by estimating that the incremental cost of terminating a new 500 kV transmission line into the existing Big Stone South and Alexandria substations will be no less than \$40 million (total).

Therefore, based on the indicative cost information provided in the Application, the Applicants estimate that constructing the Western Segment as a single-circuit 500 kV line will result in an incremental cost of more than \$100 million as compared to the constructing the Western Segment as a double-circuit 345 kV line.

Although not quantified, higher on-going maintenance and spare equipment cost is also expected if the Western Segment is constructed as a single circuit 500 kV line. Constructing a 500 kV line and installing new 500/345 kV transformers at the Big Stone South and Alexandria substations would require Otter Tail Power Company (Otter Tail) and Western Minnesota Municipal Power Agency (Western Minnesota) to introduce new 500 kV class transformers and other associated 500 kV line and substation equipment that Otter Tail and Western Minnesota do not currently own, operate or maintain. While this experience can be gained, it would be more costly because Otter Tail and Western Minnesota would be required to incur additional maintenance expenses to repair and maintain new 500/345 kV transformers in addition to the existing 345 kV class transformers. Furthermore, Otter Tail and Western Minnesota may also be required to stock spare 500 kV equipment and expand their spare transformer strategy resulting in higher costs. Constructing the Western Segment at 345 kV results in Otter Tail and Western Minnesota continuing to own, operate and maintain 345 kV class transformers and 345 kV line equipment that are more common across Minnesota with easier access to spare transformers and associated line and substation equipment.

In addition, the Applicants note that the cost for generators to interconnect to a 500 kV line are significantly higher than interconnecting to a 345 kV line. As a result, the cost of interconnecting future renewable energy projects to the Western Segment at 500 kV will be more costly than if the Western Segment was constructed at 345 kV. This is an important distinction given the increase in renewable generation that is needed as Minnesota utilities work towards meeting the state's carbon-free by 2040 law.
