#### **DECISION ITEMS**

1. \*\* E015/AI-17-568 Minnesota Power (MP)

In the Matter of Minnesota Power's Petition for Approval of the EnergyForward Resource Package.

Should the Commission adopt the Administrative Law Judge's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommendations?

Should the Commission approve the affiliated Assignment of Rights Agreements authorizing MP to act as Construction Agent and Operating Agent under the NTEC Agreements?

Should the Commission approve the affiliated CDA, dedicating 48 percent of the NTEC to MP and energy cost recovery through the FPE Rider?

Should the Commission grant a variance to and approve the associated tariff amendments to the FPE Rider to ensure that fuel costs related to MP's share of NTEC are recovered and that MISO revenues realized under the CDA flow back to customers? (PUC: **Stalpes, Kaluzniak**)
