**RE: Center for Energy and Environment's Comments In the Matter of the Minnesota Technical Reference Manual Version 5.0**

Dear Assistant Commissioner Lieb,

Center for Energy and Environment (“CEE”) respectfully submits this letter to correct an error in its November 20, 2025 Comments to the Minnesota Department of Commerce, Division of Energy Resources (“Department”) on the Proposed Decision regarding the Minnesota Technical Reference Manual (“TRM”) Version 5.0.

On pages 3 and 17 of CEE’s Comments, we state that the Wisconsin Focus on Energy Technical Reference Manual (“TRM”) furnace baseline was updated in response to a 2023 contractor survey to be 92.8 percent AFUE for market rate single-family households and 80 percent AFUE for low-income single-family households. However, these are the original baselines used in the 2023 TRM, not the updated baselines.

The correct updated baselines, which were implemented in the 2024 Wisconsin Focus on Energy TRM, are 90.6 percent for market rate households and 88.3 percent for low-income households.

CEE respectfully submits this letter to correct this error.
