I live on Charlotte Lake and wanted to share there concerns listed in this info posted on Facebook.

I am hoping that the PUC will ensure that these safety concerns would Not be an issue if the panels are placed closer than 2 miles from our houses.

I have also heard of some health concerns that have come from pulverized roads in the Solar panel area. People having respiratory issues after being exposed to the dust.

I am concerned about the glare off of the panels. I can get migraines caused from bright lights or flashes and don't want to look at that every day with the concern of migraines. I'm not sure what can be done to ensure this won't be a health concern for myself of others living so close to the solar panels.

I also feel that our county needs to be informed about the cost that could Fall on the county if anything costly happens to the Solar Project in years 0-9. This should be very clear to the residents and the county and I don't think it is . We heard about it during the in person meeting and only after we asked the question of who pays to fix things or clean up should we have damage and Geronimo doesn't decide to fix or repair.

I have bald eagles that are seen often in my back yard. I would Hate for them to go away if the solar panels scare or chase them away.

Fire... what happens if there is a fire?

Do we evacuate? How long ? Who pays for any extra cost we incur during the evacuation? Fire departments are saying they will let it burn and can only bury a solar battery fire. This seems toxic and dangerous to be so close to our homes.

I am hoping this will be looked at very closely and move the panels much further away from our homes.
