**COMPLIANCE FILING**

Enbridge Energy, Limited Partnership (“Enbridge”) submits this Compliance Filing in the above-captioned docket for its Fond du Lac Line 4 Project in Minnesota on the Fond du Lac Reservation (the “Project”). On April 11, 2019, the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (the “Commission”) issued an order finding Enbridge’s Application for the Project as complete (the “Order”). As described in more detail below, pursuant to the Order and the rules governing these proceedings, Enbridge provided notice of public information meetings and distributed copies of its Application.

**I. Public Information Meeting Notice.**

Pursuant to Minn. R. 7852.0600, subp. 2, Enbridge published newspaper notice of the application acceptance and public information meetings in each county crossed by the Project on April 26, 2019, namely *Duluth News Tribune* and *Pine Knot News*. The notice document published by the newspapers and affidavits of publication are included in **ATTACHMENT A**.

**II. Application Distribution.**

Pursuant to Minn. R. 7852.0600, subp. 2 and 7852.2000, subp. 6, and the Order, mailed copies of the Application, and of the Notice of Public Information Meetings and Comment Period (the “Notice”) were sent to local libraries, certain state agencies, local government entities and affected landowners. This mailing was completed on April 24, 2019. The Notice, cover letters, and affidavit of mailing with service lists are included in **ATTACHMENT B**.

Further, Enbridge’s Application is posted to a publicly available website so it may be accessed electronically. Specifically, Enbridge’s Project website ([www.enbridge.com/projects-and-infrastructure/public-awareness/fond-du-lac-line-4](http://www.enbridge.com/projects-and-infrastructure/public-awareness/fond-du-lac-line-4)) includes a link to the Application and provides the docket number. The notice letter also provided information on how to access the full case record on the Commission’s eDockets website, where the Application is also publicly available.

### III. Conclusion.

As set forth above, Enbridge has complied with the Order and applicable Minnesota law by publishing notice of public information meetings and distributing copies of the Application to local libraries, certain state agencies, local government entities and affected landowners.

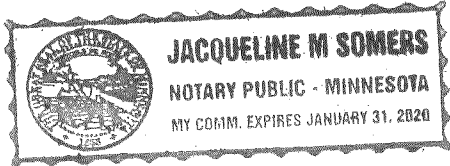

## Project Description

On March 18, 2019, Enbridge Energy, Limited Partnership (Enbridge) filed a Revised Pipeline Routing Permit and Partial Exemption Application for the Fond du Lac Line 4 Pipeline Project in Saint Louis and Carlton Counties. The proposed project entails the replacement, relocation, and burial of an approximately 10-mile segment of the Line 4 pipeline on the Fond du Lac Reservation. Construction of the project will allow deactivation, and removal of the existing Line 4 pipeline. Enbridge stated it proposed the project to address concerns raised by the Fond du Lac Band of Superior Chippewa related to the above-grade installation of the subject line because it creates a barrier to natural water flow, as well as impedes land access to tribal resources. Enbridge cited several positive impacts of the project on humans and the environment.

The proposed project would replace an existing 48-inch diameter aboveground pipeline with a 36-inch diameter underground pipeline. Associated facilities with the project include mainline valves, access roads, and cathodic protection equipment. The replacement pipeline would be placed along the south side of the existing Enbridge Mainline Corridor.

Enbridge stated the project would cost approximately \$100 million. The proposed project would be placed in-service in the 3rd Quarter of 2020.

The Commission will decide whether to grant or deny the partial exemption based upon any comments received, the information in the record, and the criteria set forth in Minnesota Rule 7852.0700, Subp. 3. If the Commission does not grant the partial exemption, Enbridge may submit its application pursuant to the Commission's full pipeline route selection procedures.

The public information meeting is intended to inform the public about the permitting process, to compile information to assist the Commission in determining whether to grant or deny the partial exemption application, and to afford an opportunity for members of the public to submit comments. In deciding whether to grant or deny the partial exemption, the Commission will consider comments filed, the information contained in the application and the record as a whole relevant to the criteria for a partial exemption. If the Commission grants a partial exemption, it will issue a pipeline route permit.

On February 25, 2019, in response to a request from the Fond du Lac Band of Lake Superior Chippewa ("Fond du Lac"), Enbridge Energy, Limited Partnership ("Enbridge") filed an application for a route permit and partial exemption from certain pipeline routing permit procedures with the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (the "Commission"). Enbridge filed a revised application on March 15, 2019.

As proposed, the Project would relocate and bury approximately 10 miles of the existing Line 4 pipeline from the center of the existing Enbridge Mainline Corridor (the "Corridor") to the outer edge of the Corridor within the Fond du Lac Reservation in St. Louis and Carlton Counties. 
