

The Commission met on **Thursday, March 17, 2022**, with Chair Sieben and Commissioners Means, Schuerger, Sullivan, and Tuma present.

The following matters were taken up by the Commission:

**E-002, 111/SA-22-38**

**In the Matter of the Joint Request of Northern States Power Company, d/b/a Xcel Energy, and Dakota Electric Association for Approval of Three Compensation and Orderly Transfer Agreements Between the Two Parties**

Commissioner Tuma moved that the Commission approve both the permanent service territory transfer from Dakota Electric Association (the Cooperative) to Northern States Power Company, d/b/a Xcel Energy (Xcel), and the permanent service territory transfers from Xcel to the Cooperative, and request that MnGEO update the Commission's maps to reflect the service area designations as shown on the maps in the petition.

The motion passed 5–0.

**In the Matter of Great River Energy's Request for an Extension for Filing Its Next Integrated Resource Plan**

**ET-2/RP-22-75**

**In the Matter of Great River Energy's 2022-2036 Integrated Resource Plan**

Commissioner Tuma moved that the Commission

1. Approve Great River Energy's request to extend the due date for filing its integrated resource plan from April 1, 2022, to April 1, 2023.

2. Require Great River Energy to file an interim update on issues impacting its future integrated resource plan by Monday, October 3, 2022. At a minimum, the interim update should provide updated information concerning changes in fixed members' demand and energy purchases from Great River Energy, along with stakeholder and member engagement regarding the plan.
3. Accept Great River Energy's offer to provide the following information in the interim update regarding its agreement with Rainbow Energy Center, LLC:
  - i. The price (\$/kilowatt-hour) that Great River Energy will pay for electricity from Rainbow Energy.
  - ii. Any capacity price or demand charge (\$/megawatt).

The motion passed 5–0.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
