This letter constitutes the Reply Comments of the Delano Water, Light, and Power Commission ("Delano") in this matter. Delano has reviewed and appreciates the Department of Commerce ("Department") comments and recommendation of approval in this matter.

As noted by the Department, the parties' records differ in the number of similarly affected customers by two (Delano identified 13 and Wright-Hennepin identified 15). Delano has not received any updated information from Wright-Hennepin in this regard. Nonetheless, Delano notes that this difference should not affect the Commission's decision-making. Delano's recent policy will apply to all eligible customers under the criteria, regardless of the anticipated number of customers. Therefore, as properly concluded by the Department, the Commission should consider the merits of the joint petition and the Department's recommendation of approval.
