In the Matter of Minnesota Power's Petition for Approval of Modifications to its Large Power Tariff

Topics Open for Comment:

- Does Minnesota Power's proposal comply with Minn. Stat. § 216B.1622 related to Service for Very Large Customers (Laws 2025, 1st Special Session, Chapter 12)? If not, what additional provisions should be addressed?
- Are there other issues or concerns related to this matter?

Background: On June 14, 2025, legislation was passed which aimed to make Minnesota a more competitive destination for large-scale customers through targeted changes to the state's tax incentive framework. The legislation included provisions affecting electric utility regulation and rate design for very large customers. The legislation included provisions regarding electric utility regulation and rate design for data centers and other very large customers. Specifically, the law requires the Commission to evaluate how best to achieve appropriate outcomes for proposed tariffs applicable to these customers. In doing so, the Commission must consider issues such as cost assignment, alignment with the state's electricity and clean energy standards, and customer protections.

On February 18, 2026, Minnesota Power (MP or the Company) filed a Petition for Approval of Modification to Large Power tariff. Minnesota Power is seeking approval of its proposal to accommodate very large power customers within its existing Large Power ("LP") Customer Class and Large Power Service Schedule. The Company submits this Petition in response to the Commission's requirement under Minn. Stat. § 216B.1622, Subd. 1.
