Thank you for the opportunity to review and comment on the Environmental Assessment (EA) for the Elk Creek Solar Project (Project) located in Magnolia and Vienna, Rock County, Minnesota. The Project consists of a 160 megawatt (MW) solar generation facility in Magnolia and Vienna Townships in Rock County, Minnesota. The project would provide 160 MW of electrical generation for which Elk Creek Solar has executed Generation Interconnection Agreements with the Midcontinent Independent System Operator (MISO). Regarding matters for which the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) has regulatory responsibility and other interests, the MPCA staff has the following comments for your consideration.

## **Construction Stormwater**

The site has a lot of stormwater basins. During the construction planning if an area has 10 or more acres drain to a common area the permittee must use a temporary sedimentation basin to treat water before it leaves the construction site or enters a surface water. This requirement changes to 5 acres if the site is draining into a special or impaired water. MPCA CSW permit item 14.2.

The 2023 construction stormwater permit has some changes that may impact solar sites regarding vegetation. If the permittee uses pollinator habitat or native vegetation during reestablishment of the landscape the inspection frequency and when they can stop inspecting has changed. Further information is found in MPCA CSW permit item 11.11.
