As there are 3 topics open for comment I will use a number 1-3 to differentiate my comments.

1. Affected area restoration. I have no comment on this topic.

2. Commission Accept or Reject. I think the commission should Reject the certification of completion as Heartland Corn Products has failed to secure easements or access to adjacent properties that are in their claimed safety zone. Their pipeline operator continues to access adjacent properties and tell adjacent property owners what they can and cannot do on their property. I spoke with Tom Paitrik in 19 Jun 2025 about the situation and offered a very simple solution. HCP has not resolved the problem.

3. Costs or Reimbursements due. Yes the adjacent landowners were not told about the safety corridor until after the project. That situation will lead to litigation for compensation of property rights. I feel that the completion certificate should be rejected until the adjacent property owners are compensated for loss of property rights.
