They have sent me a notice stating that they have put my interconnection application On Hold and will not take any further action on my application until all projects ahead of me are reviewed. I've already been waiting a year, and there are still 12 others ahead of me in the queue. This is an unfair and unethical practice as I have every right to be able to offset my electrical load.

Repercussions that are inevitable if Xcel continues to keep the application "on hold", includes significant financial loss. This delay will prevent me from not only saving money on my electricity bills but possibly earning money from the solar production as well. There is also the rebate incentive that is unable to be utilized. Lastly, the solar tax credit will decrease and even disappear if I have to wait years to be able to install the energy system.

To solve the issue, I would like to request that the Public Utilities Commission require that Xcel remove my application from "on hold" and continue the review immediately.
