The Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (DNR) has reviewed the draft site permit for the Nobles 2 Wind Project in Nobles County. We offer the following comments and recommendations for your consideration:

It is our agency's understanding that the great blue heron rookery identified in the site permit application is approximately 10.9 miles from the nearest turbine. Therefore, no further review of the rookery is necessary.

The DNR's comment letter (March 20, 2018) recommended that, in the absence of moving an adequate number of turbines to achieve a low risk designation, Nobles 2 post-construction fatality monitoring would require inclusion of three turbines near the WMAs. The direct testimony of Joseph Finocchiaro states that Nobles 2 is willing to revise its post-construction monitoring protocol to include monitoring of three turbines near the WMAs. The DNR encourages timely modification of the Bird and Bat Conservation Strategy to reflect the site's moderate risk level and the changes in monitoring protocol, including a minimum of two search days per week for fatality monitoring rather than one day per week.

Native prairie has been identified within the site boundaries. Hence, the DNR advises that preparation of a prairie protection and management plan in consultation with our agency is needed per section 4.7 of the draft site permit.

Other issues brought forth during project coordination have been adequately addressed.
