## 1. \*\* E999/CI-03-802 All Commission-Regulated Electric Utilities

In the Matter of an Investigation into the Appropriateness of Electric Energy Cost Adjustments.

- 1. Should the Commission change the implementation date of the New Annual Fuel Clause Adjustment Requirements to January 1, 2020?
- 2. What new Annual Fuel Clause Adjustment review process should the Commission adopt?
- 3. What action should the Commission take regarding unresolved issues? (PUC: Alonso, Bender, Bonnett)

Implementation date revised to 1/1/2020; Monthly AA filings discontinued; Further implementation modifications established; Further stakeholder development of issues required.

### 2. \*\* E999/R-18-518 Goodhue Wind Truth

In the Matter of the Possible Rulemaking to Amend Minnesota Rules Chapter 7854.

 Should the Commission undertake a rulemaking to amend Minnesota Rules Chapter 7854, and if so, should the Commission appoint an advisory task force? (PUC: DeBleeckere)

Denied rulemaking petition without prejudice.

### 3. \*\* IP6946/WS-17-410 Freeborn Wind Energy LLC

In the Matter of the Application of Freeborn Wind Energy LLC for a Large Wind Energy Conversion System Site Permit for the 84 MW Freeborn Wind Farm in Freeborn County.

- 1. Should the Commission adopt the administrative law judge's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommendations?
- 2. Should the Commission grant a site permit for the up to 84 megawatt Freeborn Wind Farm in Freeborn County? (PUC: **Kaluzniak**)

Adopted ALJ Report with the exception of Finding of Fact 206 with staff modifications; Required that preconstruction noise analysis be updated; authorized issuance of draft site permit authorized by the PUC in 1/30/18 Order with recommended permit amendments; and authorized further staff refinements to ALJ report for consistency.

- \* IP6946/TL-17-322 Freeborn Wind Energy LLC In the Matter of the Application of Freeborn Wind Energy LLC for a Route Permit for the Freeborn Wind Transmission Line in Freeborn County.
  - 1. Should the Commission adopt the Administrative Law Judge's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommendation?
  - 2. Should the Commission find that the environmental assessment and the record created at the public hearing adequately address the issues identified in the scoping decision?
  - Should the Commission issue a route permit identifying a specific route and permit conditions for the Freeborn Wind 115 kV Transmission Line Project? (PUC: Kaluzniak)

Modified, approved, and adopted ALJ FOF and Conclusion; found that EA and record addressed issues raised in scoping; issued proposed HVRL route permit with conditions; required site permit to include special conditions included in ALJ Report, and authorized Staff refinements to ALJ report for consistency.
