Dear Judge McKenzie,

Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (Commission), Energy Infrastructure Permitting (EIP) staff offers the following comments on the proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommendations (Findings) provided by Benton Solar, LLC (Benton Solar) for the Benton Solar Project (project).¹

EIP staff has reviewed Benton Solar's proposed Findings and believes that they accurately reflect the environmental review and permitting process for the project.

EIP staff has no comment on proposed Finding 225. Proposed Finding 225 states:

Based on the evidence in the record, Benton Solar will be constructed with a significant amount of local labor, which will have direct and indirect positive economic impacts in Benton County and the region around the Project. There is sufficient evidence in the record that Benton Solar has committed to having its EPC utilize union labor, that the use of union labor will result in the use of local labor, and that the EPC has agreements with unions to staff the construction jobs for the Project.

EIP staff believes this Finding is contingent on the outcome of the contested case between Benton Solar and Laborers' International Union of North America (LIUNA). As such, EIP staff has no comment on this Finding.
