We live just east of where this proposed solar facility is supposedly going to be built. We are on the east side of Hwy 15. We have many concerns about this. If the tile are broke when the panels are installed, are you going to repair them? Having broken tile will affect our farmland as the water won't be dispersed as it should.

Another concern we have is in regard to the property tax on the land that will now be taken out of production. How will the property taxes be billed for this land that is no longer going to be farmland? This will also affect the rest of the farmland's property taxes in Rutland township.

There are many hog barns on this project footprint, 23 approximately. When a hog barn is built, the producer is to report where they are going to haul and spread the manure, which is usually the land adjacent to the barns. So with all of this land taken out of production, where is all of the manure going to be hauled? Is it going to be hauled farther away, causing more wear and tear on our gravel roads? Or are the producers going to get compensated so well they won't be putting pigs in the barns anymore? We would like to know what the plan is for this.

We would like to have responses to these concerns besides " we will take this into consideration".
