The following matters were taken up by the Commission:

E-324,137/SA-24-287

In the Matter of the Joint Request of the City of Warroad and Roseau Electric Cooperative to Modify Electric Service Territory Boundaries

Commissioner Tuma moved that the Commission approve the joint request of the City of Warroad and Roseau Electric Cooperative, and request the Minnesota Geospatial Information Office update the service territory map to reflect the changes on the map as provided in the application and by the Minnesota Department of Commerce.

The motion passed 5–0.

P-421/C-20-432

In the Matter of a Formal Complaint Regarding the Services Provided by the Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink in Minnesota, on Behalf of the Communications Workers of America

Commissioner Means moved that the Commission deny the petition of Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC to reconsider the Commission’s Order Finding Breach of Service Quality Rules and Establishing Remedies (September 17, 2024).

In the Matter of the Petition of Northern States Power Co. d/b/a Xcel Energy for Approval of its Proposed Community Solar Garden Program

Commissioner Ham moved that the Commission adopt the alternative proposal as described in the September 24, 2024 comments of Northern States Power Co. d/b/a Xcel Energy and approve the proposed tariffs which are attached to Xcel Energy's comments.
