The route permit for the Forks 161 kV Switching Station and Forks-Rost 161 kV Transmission Line Project in Jackson County, MN, is outside of these areas. We believe your project does not impact our Triba, our Tribal properties, our Tribal cultural properties, does not infringe on our usufruct rights, and have no effect on our Tribal citizens' health. Consequently, this project is not of interest to us.
