

Dear Customer:

As you may know, Owatonna Public Utilities (OPU) has reached an agreement with Steele-Waseca Cooperative Electric (SWCE) in which OPU will provide electric service to certain customers formerly assigned to SWCE, including your property. OPU either recently began providing your electric service, or will be providing electric service in the near future. The utilities are in the process of formally updating the electric service maps on file with the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (MPUC) to reflect that OPU is the assigned electric service provider. This letter provides information concerning that proceeding before the MPUC.

The MPUC is a state agency with jurisdiction over electric service territory boundaries. The MPUC requires notice to customers located in an area involved in a change in the service territory maps. This letter provides that formal notice.
