I. INTRODUCTION

The Minnesota Public Utilities Commission's (Commission) April 21, 2025 *Order Approving Settlement Agreement with Modifications* at points 11 to 17 selected projects for the short list in this proceeding.¹ This short list included several projects involving power purchase agreements (PPA), which the Commission approved to proceed to the PPA negotiation phase. National Grid Renewables Development, LLC subsequently withdrew one of these short-listed PPA projects, the Plum Creek Wind + Storage project.² The Plum Creek Wind + Storage project would have consisted of a new 230 MW wind generating system and a 150 MW/ 600 MWh battery energy storage system (BESS) anticipated to begin operation in late 2028.³

In the initial Petition, Xcel requested approval of PPAs for the following three of the remaining short-listed projects:⁴

- Invenergy – Cannon Falls: an existing 357 MW gas-fired facility;
- Onward – Mankato Energy Center: an existing 375 MW gas-fired combined cycle facility and a new BESS; and
- DESRI – North Star Energy: a new 100 MW BESS.

In its Petition Xcel also stated that it was actively pursuing alternative projects to replace the withdrawn Plum Creek Wind + Storage project bid.⁵ In its Petition Supplement, Xcel identifies Panamint – Cottage Grove BESS as the replacement project.⁶ The Cottage Grove BESS project is a new 80 MW/ 320 MWh BESS co-located at the existing Cottage Grove Cogeneration facility, a 265 MW combined-cycle gas turbine plant.⁷ The project has an expected commercial operation date (COD) of June 1, 2028.⁸

In the Petition Supplement Xcel specifically requests that the Commission:⁹

- approve the proposed Panamint – Cottage Grove BESS PPA;
- authorize Xcel to recover, through the Fuel Clause Rider (FCR), pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 216B.16 subd. 7(3), the Minnesota jurisdictional portion of the costs incurred under the PPAs; and
- establish a procedural schedule such that the Commission may complete deliberations by mid-January 2026.

II. PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

April 21, 2025	The Commission issued the Order approving a settlement of Xcel’s resource plan proceeding and a short list in Xcel’s process to acquire 800 MW of firm dispatchable generation. ¹⁰
April 25, 2025	National Grid Renewables Development, LLC filed a letter stating that the Plum Creek Wind + Storage Project, which was on the approved short list, was being withdrawn. ¹¹
September 29, 2025	Xcel filed its Petition requesting approval of the PPAs for three of the remaining projects on the short list and stating that it was actively pursuing alternative projects to replace the withdrawn Plum Creek project. ¹²
November 3, 2025	The Department filed comments on Xcel’s Petition. ¹³
December 5, 2025	Xcel filed the Petition Supplement identifying Cottage Grove BESS as its proposed replacement for the withdrawn Plum Creek project and requesting the Commission find the Cottage Grove BESS PPA to be in the public interest and to authorize the Company to recover costs through the FCR. ¹⁴
December 9, 2025	The Commission issued its <i>Notice of Comment Period</i> . ¹⁵

According to the Notice, the topics open for comment are:

- Should the Commission approve the Purchased Power Agreement (PPA)?
- Should the Commission authorize the Company to recover the Minnesota jurisdictional portion of the costs incurred under the PPA from Minnesota retail customers?
- Are there any other topics related to this matter?

III. DEPARTMENT ANALYSIS

A. ENCOMPASS EVALUATION

Xcel conducted updated EnCompass modeling to evaluate the benefits of the Cottage Grove BESS project.¹⁶ The Company compared its baseline capacity expansion plan to an updated capacity expansion plan in which the Cottage Grove BESS project is forced into the model. The baseline capacity expansion plan included the solar and storage projects in Xcel's 2024 RFP portfolio,¹⁷ Xcel's latest load forecast, and production tax credits (PTC) only through 2030.¹⁸

The Petition Supplement at Table 3 presents the present value of social costs (PVSC) and present value of revenue requirement (PVRR) from the baseline and Cottage Grove BESS capacity expansion plans produced by EnCompass.¹⁹ The Cottage Grove BESS project adds \$300 million to the PVRR and \$5 million to the PVSC. These additional costs represent 0.465% and 0.006% of the total baseline PVRR and PVSC, respectively. The Department notes that the PVSC consists of the PVRR plus the regulatory and environmental costs of CO₂ emissions. Therefore, since the PVSC impact is smaller than the PVRR impact, the Department concludes that Cottage Grove BESS decreases Xcel's total modeled CO₂ emissions, and thus regulatory and environmental costs. Given that the PVSC impact is minimal and likely within the margin of error of the model, the Department agrees that the EnCompass modeling results demonstrate a reasonable cost impact associated with the Cottage Grove BESS PPA pricing.

B. PPA REVIEW

In its *Order Approving Settlement Agreement With Modifications*, the Commission provided direction on the issues to be evaluated in reviewing PPAs for the short-listed projects:

19. The evaluation of these non-utility bidders' projects PPAs as contemplated in the settlement agreement will include, but not be limited to, whether:
 - a. the prices and terms put ratepayers at risk for costs that are higher than bid or for benefits assumed in bids that do not materialize;
 - b. the agreements had terms which sufficiently protected ratepayers from risks associated with the non-deliverability of accredited capacity and/or energy from the project(s) as proposed;

- c. the terms of any agreements that inappropriately shifted risk or unknown costs to ratepayers; and
- d. the reasonableness of delay and cancellation provisions.²⁰

The Commission’s *Notice of Comment Period* for the Petition Supplement does not explicitly reference this Order Point. However, given that the Cottage Grove BESS project is intended to replace a project included in the Commission’s short list, the Department concludes that it is appropriate to consider those four issues in the following sections to evaluate whether the Commission should approve the Cottage Grove BESS PPA.

B.1. Pricing Evaluation

The first issue listed in the Order’s point 19 is if the prices and terms put ratepayers at risk for costs that are higher than bid or for benefits assumed in bids that do not materialize.²¹ Also, related to pricing, the Order at point 1b states that costs must be capped at bid amounts as of October 2, 2024.²² However, increases above the bid amount are allowed if Xcel demonstrates by substantial evidence that the added costs were caused by events outside of Xcel’s control and are otherwise prudent.²³

The Cottage Grove BESS PPA includes fixed capacity payments of **[TRADE SECRET DATA HAS BEEN EXCISED]**.²⁴ Since the Cottage Grove BESS project was not included in the original bids as of October 2, 2024, the Department is unable to directly address Order point 1b. However, since the Cottage Grove BESS project is intended to replace the withdrawn Plum Creek project, the Department instead compares the pricing in the Cottage Grove BESS PPA to (1) the pricing in the Plum Creek bid filed on July 23, 2024²⁵ and (2) the pricing in the PPA for North Star BESS, a comparable BESS project short-listed in the Order and for which Xcel requested approval in its initial Petition.²⁶ See Table 1 below for this comparison.

The Cottage Grove BESS pricing of **[TRADE SECRET DATA HAS BEEN EXCISED]** is **[TRADE SECRET DATA HAS BEEN EXCISED]** the pricing for the storage component of the Plum Creek project in National Grid Renewables, LLC's bid. The Department notes that these two projects are not directly comparable, as the planned Plum Creek project would have included nearly twice the storage capacity of Cottage Grove BESS. Additionally, Plum Creek would have included storage and wind components, both of which were to be built as new facilities. These project components may have resulted in a different pricing structure compared to the Cottage Grove BESS project, which consists of building a new BESS facility at an existing combined-cycle gas plant site. Despite these differences, the Department notes that the Cottage Grove BESS project is proposed as a replacement for the Plum Creek project, so it is important to consider the pricing differences between the two projects.

The Department also compares the Cottage Grove BESS pricing to the pricing in the North Star BESS PPA, of which Xcel filed for approval in its initial Petition.²⁷ The North Star BESS bid included pricing for an 80 MW facility (the same capacity as Cottage Grove) and an alternative 50 MW facility; the North Star BESS PPA included pricing for a 100 MW facility and an alternative 80 MW facility²⁸. The Cottage Grove BESS PPA pricing of **[TRADE SECRET DATA HAS BEEN EXCISED]** is **[TRADE SECRET DATA HAS BEEN EXCISED]** the original bid pricing for the 80 MW North Star BESS and **[TRADE SECRET DATA HAS BEEN EXCISED]** the final pricing in the North Star BESS PPA. The North Star BESS PPA includes a provision allowing an increase in the capacity payment rate of up to 20%, which would raise the payment rate to **[TRADE SECRET DATA HAS BEEN EXCISED]** in the event of certain new trade measures such as increased tariffs on critical equipment.²⁹ The Cottage Grove BESS PPA **[TRADE SECRET DATA HAS BEEN EXCISED]**

Although **[TRADE SECRET DATA HAS BEEN EXCISED]** the Department notes that, as Xcel discussed in both its initial Petition³⁰ and the Petition Supplement,³¹ several emerging market challenges influenced PPA negotiations. The Cottage Grove BESS PPA includes **[TRADE SECRET DATA HAS BEEN EXCISED]** Therefore, the Department concludes that the PPA offers reasonable pricing and does not put ratepayers at substantial risk related to cost.

The Department also reviewed the PPA's excess throughput payment provision, since this provision introduces potential additional costs based on Xcel's operation of the Cottage Grove BESS. The PPA sets an annual throughput limit of **[TRADE SECRET DATA HAS BEEN EXCISED]**. Energy discharged in excess of this limit incurs an additional charge of **[TRADE SECRET DATA HAS BEEN EXCISED]**. However, **[TRADE SECRET DATA HAS BEEN EXCISED]**. The Department concludes that the excess throughput payment provision does not introduce significant risk to ratepayers.

B.2. Evaluation of Deliverability Protections

The second issue listed in the Order's point 19 is if the PPAs had terms that sufficiently protected ratepayers from risks associated with the non-deliverability of accredited capacity and/or energy from the project(s) as proposed.³²

The Cottage Grove BESS PPA protects ratepayers from the non-deliverability of capacity and energy via the capacity availability factor (CAF).³³ The CAF adjusts the monthly capacity payment to ensure that Xcel only pays for the actual available capacity of the BESS by reducing the capacity payments to account for unavailability due to forced outages or underperformance. **[TRADE SECRET DATA HAS BEEN EXCISED]**

Details on the CAF calculation, and how it is applied to the payment structure, can be found in **[TRADE SECRET DATA HAS BEEN EXCISED]** The PPA requires that the CAF **[TRADE SECRET DATA HAS BEEN EXCISED]**

The PPA also includes ratepayer protection from the non-deliverability of capacity due to variation in the BESS round-trip efficiency. If the facility's round-trip efficiency is found to be lower than the guaranteed value in **[TRADE SECRET DATA HAS BEEN EXCISED]** then a round-trip efficiency adjustment is used to reduce the capacity payment.³⁴ This adjustment considers **[TRADE SECRET DATA HAS BEEN EXCISED]**

The PPA requires **[TRADE SECRET DATA HAS BEEN EXCISED]**

The Department concludes that the PPA sufficiently protects ratepayers from risks associated with the non-deliverability of capacity and energy from the Cottage Grove BESS.

B.3. Risk Evaluation

The third issue listed in the Order's point 19 is if the terms of any agreements inappropriately shifted risk or unknown costs to ratepayers.³⁵

The Department reviewed the Cottage Grove BESS PPA and found several provisions designed to protect ratepayers from risks and unknown costs. Since this project involves building a new BESS facility, construction delays and failure to meet the target commercial operation date (COD) are key risks addressed in the PPA. These risks are handled by the provisions reviewed in section B.5 below. The delay and cancellation provisions provide sufficient protections including liquidated delay damages

paid to Xcel in the event of a delay. Xcel is permitted to draw these and other damages from a security fund that the Seller is required to establish and maintain.³⁶ Additional terms protecting ratepayers from risks and unknown costs include the following:

- Xcel owns environmental attributes.³⁷
- If the Seller fails to respond to a dispatch notice, then resulting penalties assessed by the market operator are passed to the Seller.³⁸
- The required security fund **[TRADE SECRET DATA HAS BEEN EXCISED]**

The Department notes that **[TRADE SECRET DATA HAS BEEN EXCISED]**

The Department finds that the PPA does not shift any significant risks or unknown costs to ratepayers, and that it includes sufficient provisions protecting ratepayers from risks and unknown costs.

B.4. Evaluation of Timeliness Provisions

The fourth issue listed in the Order's point 19 is the reasonableness of delay and cancellation provisions.³⁹

The Cottage Grove BESS PPA establishes a target COD of June 1, 2028⁴⁰ and sets deadlines for critical path development (CPD) milestones that the Seller is required to meet, subject to liquidated delay damages.⁴¹ These CPD milestones include:

If the Seller fails to meet a CPD deadline or the COD **[TRADE SECRET HAS BEEN EXCISED]** then Xcel has the right to terminate the PPA and collect liquidated damages in the amount of **[TRADE SECRET DATA HAS BEEN EXCISED]** from the Seller.

The PPA also includes cancellation provisions regarding **[TRADE SECRET DATA T HAS BEEN EXCISED]**

The Department's review of these sections did not reveal any risks of note. The Department finds that the delay and cancellation provisions in the PPA are reasonable.

B.5. Summary of Evaluation

The Department evaluated the Cottage Grove BESS PPA using the criteria established in the Commission's April 21, 2025 Order in Docket Nos. E002/CN-23-212 and E002/RP-24-67.⁴² The Department concludes that, within the broader context of the projects that the Commission short-listed in its Order,⁴³ and considering the market challenges impacting negotiations, the pricing in the PPA is reasonable. The PPA also has sufficient terms to ensure performance of the facility and protect ratepayers from paying for non-deliverable capacity. These terms include the CAF, round-trip efficiency adjustment, and testing protocols. The PPA satisfactorily protects ratepayers from risks and unknown costs through the security fund, **[TRADE SECRET DATA HAS BEEN EXCISED]** and project milestones. Since the PPA involves constructing a new BESS facility, delay and cancellation provisions are a key component of the PPA. The PPA includes reasonable terms to enforce key deadlines as well as comprehensive seller default provisions.

C. FCR RECOVERY

The Petition Supplement requests the Commission authorize the Company to recover, through the FCR, pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 216B.16 subd. 7(3), the Minnesota jurisdictional portion of the costs incurred under the PPAs from Minnesota retail customers.⁴⁴ Specifically, Xcel states:

Because the project satisfies the conditions of a qualifying facility, the Company plans to recover the costs of this agreement through our Fuel Clause Rider.⁴⁵

The Department notes that energy costs incurred by PPAs are recovered via Xcel's FCR. Capacity costs due to PPAs are included in base rates and are also addressed in a capacity tracker for a true-up of base rate recovery to actuals. It is unclear whether the monthly capacity payments in the Cottage Grove BESS PPA are included in the costs that Xcel plans to recover through the FCA. Since these payments are capacity costs, the Department's understanding is that they are addressed in base rates and the capacity tracker, and not eligible for FCR recovery. The energy costs recoverable via Xcel's FCR could include the cost of energy that Xcel buys to charge the BESS, less the revenue from the discharging energy that Xcel sells. Energy costs could also include excess throughput payments if Xcel incurs these charges.

D. COMMISSION NOTICE

D.1. Approve the PPAs?

According to the Notice, the first topic open for comment is “Should the Commission approve the Purchased Power Agreement (PPA)?”

The Department recommends that the Commission approve the Cottage Grove BESS PPA.

D.2. Authorizing Fuel Clause Recovery

According to the Notice, the second topic open for comment is “Should the Commission authorize the Company to recover the Minnesota jurisdictional portion of the costs incurred under the PPA from Minnesota retail customers?”

Minn. Stat. § 216B.16 subd. 7(3) states that:

[...] the Commission may permit a public utility to file rate schedules containing provisions for the automatic adjustment of charges for public utility service in direct relation to changes in [...] costs for fuel used in generation of electricity.⁴⁶

As discussed in Section C, the Department’s understanding is that only energy costs are eligible for recovery through Xcel’s FCR, and that capacity costs are addressed in base rates and the capacity tracker. The Department recommends that Xcel clarify in reply comments whether it is requesting to recover capacity payments through the FCR. If it is requesting to recover capacity payments through the FCR, the Department recommends that Xcel provide a justification for the eligibility of these costs for FCR recovery.

D.3. Other Issues

According to the Notice, the third topic open for comment is “Are there any other topics related to this matter?”

The Department has no other issues or concerns.

IV. DEPARTMENT RECOMMENDATIONS

Based on analysis of the information in the record, the Department has prepared recommendations, which are provided below. The recommendations correspond to the subheadings of Section III above.
