***Subject: Dakota Electric Association Comments in Response to
April 10, 2026 Notice of Comment Period***

***In the Matter of Updating the Generic Standards for the Interconnection
and Operation of Distributed Generation Facilities Established under Minn.
Stat. §216B.1611
Docket No. E999/CI-16-521***

Dear Ms. Bergman:

Dakota Electric Association (Dakota Electric or Cooperative) respectfully submits these comments in response to the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission's (Commission) April 10, 2026 Notice of Comment Period in the above referenced docket.

I. Background

On April 14, 2024, the Commission issued an order with the following directives for the Distribution Generation Working Group (DGWG):

6. The Commission directs the DGWG to explore whether and how a new interconnection screen or interconnection track should be created for non-exporting DER applications under 40 kW AC.

7. The Commission directs the DGWG to explore if and how battery storage systems should be evaluated under the MN DIP. Topics to discuss would include: should the battery storage and DER generation be studied on a combined basis in the interconnection process, and whether or not net-metered DER plus storage applications should be treated differently under the MN DIP than non-exporting DER plus storage applications.

On March 14, 2025, and July 10, 2025, the DGWG held educational sessions regarding national standards and capabilities of Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS) to establish baseline knowledge for the DGWG Technical Subgroup (TSG).

Beginning on June 2, 2025, and throughout the remainder of 2025, the TSG met 17 times to discuss and work through changes to the MN DIP and TIIR.

On April 10, 2026, the Commission issued a Notice of Comment Period (Notice) where it identified the issue:

Should the Commission approve the Technical Subgroup's proposed changes to the Minnesota Distributed Energy Resource Technical Interconnection and Interoperability Requirements (TIIR) and the Minnesota Distributed Energy Resources Interconnection Process (MN DIP) regarding Battery Energy Storage Systems and Limited/Non-Export Systems?

The Commission also opened the following topics for comment:

1. Should the Commission adopt the TSG's proposed changes to the TIIR as found in Attachment B of this Notice?
2. Should the Commission adopt the TSG's proposed changes to the TIIR as found in Attachment C to this Notice?
3. What action should the Commission take regarding the three disputed items in the TSG's report as found in Attachment A to this notice?
4. Should the Commission extend the temporary annual reporting on interconnection through at least 2030 by modifying the requirement in the August 13, 2018 Order (paragraph 20)?
 - a. Should the Commission make any changes to these reporting requirements?
5. Are there other issues or concerns related to this matter?

Additionally, the April 10, 2026 Notice included *Attachment A: Energy Storage System Subgroup Report* which includes the Energy Storage TSG's recommendations for changes to the MN DIP and TIIR.

II. Dakota Electric Comments

Dakota Electric would like to begin by acknowledging the efforts of the other parties involved in the TSG and outside industry experts. Dakota Electric specifically appreciates the extensive work and effort of the Interstate Renewable Energy Council (IREC) for facilitating the Energy Storage System Subgroup and IREC's preparation of the Energy Storage System Subgroup Report.

The Cooperative is an active participant in the DGWG and has been involved in the TSG's investigation of Battery Energy Storage Systems and Limited/Non-Export Systems. Dakota Electric continues to believe that the issue of Limited/Non-exporting systems, and how they are treated, is important as the technology continues to advance and more distributed energy resources systems are connected to the distribution grid. The Cooperative believes the work the TSG has done is the proper first step in addressing this important issue. Dakota Electric separately addresses the issues in the Commission's notice of comment below.

Should the Commission approve the Technical Subgroup's proposed changes to the Minnesota Distributed Energy Resource Technical Interconnection and Interoperability Requirements (TIIR) and the Minnesota Distributed Energy Resources Interconnection Process (MN DIP) regarding Battery Energy Storage Systems and Limited/Non-Export Systems?

Yes. The Commission should approve these two changes; however, this approval is subject to decisions on the three contested items discussed below.

Should the Commission adopt the TSG's proposed changes to the TIIR as found in Attachment B of this Notice?

Dakota Electric recommends that the Commission adopt the TSG's proposed changes to the MN TIIR as written in Attachment B of the April 10 Notice. Dakota Electric notes that the workgroup came to consensus on all the proposed changes to the MN TIIR.

Should the Commission adopt the TSG's proposed changes to the TIIR as found in Attachment C to this Notice?

Dakota Electric believes there is a slight error in the question that requires clarification. Specifically, we believe the question should reference the proposed changes to the MN DIP in Attachment C in lieu of the TIIR. Dakota Electric recommends that the Commission adopt the TSG's proposed changes as written in Attachment C of the April 10 Notice, except for the three contested items. Dakota Electric discusses these contested items below.

What action should the Commission take regarding the three disputed items in the TSG's report as found in Attachment A to this notice?

Contested item #1:

Contested item #1 regards changes to the Applicability of the MN DIP and whether it applies to DERs with no larger than 10 MW Nameplate Rating or Export Capacity. It is important to understand the definitions of both of these terms as they appear in the MN DIP. The proposed definition of Export Capacity is a new definition in the MN DIP and TIIR. This definition as currently written was developed as a consensus item. The Nameplate Rating definition is currently included in both the MN DIP and TIIR with no proposed modifications.

Export Capacity - The amount of power that can be delivered from the DER to the Area EPS as measured at the Point of Common Coupling. Export Capacity is either the Nameplate Rating, or a lower amount if limited using an acceptable means identified in Section 5.14.3 and the MN Technical Requirements, i.e., TIIR Section 11.¹

Nameplate Rating - nominal voltage (V), current (A), maximum active power (kWac), apparent power (kVA), and reactive power (kvar) at which

a DER is capable of sustained operation. For a Local EPS with multiple DER units, the aggregate nameplate rating is equal to the sum of all DERs nameplate rating in the Local EPS, not including aggregate capacity limiting mechanisms such as coincidence factors, plant controller limits, etc. that may be applicable for specific cases (Aggregate Nameplate Rating). The nameplate ratings referenced in the MN DIP are alternating current nameplate DER ratings.²

Dakota Electric emphasizes that the Nameplate Rating of a DER is the *maximum active power, apparent power, and reactive power at which a DER is capable of sustained operation*. The Nameplate Rating of a DER does not include load and is representative of the full generating capability of a DER. The Export Capacity of a DER is measured at the Point of Common Coupling which is either the nameplate rating or a lower value, which, could include local load and is not representative of the entire generating capability, or output, of a DER. The Export Capacity alone cannot represent a definitive measure of DER capacity.

If the Commission decides that Export Capacity should be used for applicability, this conclusion will have broad implications affecting other dockets, tariffs, and proceedings beyond the MN DIP. The Cooperative also notes that this contested item is significantly related to Docket Nos. 24-200 and 25-86. Dakota Electric further notes that there is an open comment period regarding a Rulemaking to Amend the Definition of “Capacity” under Minn. R. 7835.0100 in Docket No. 25-86.

Dakota Electric provides two suggestions for the Commission regarding this contested item. First, the Commission could consider taking no action on this contested item until after the Rulemaking in Docket 25-86 has been completed. Second, the Commission could reject any changes to MN DIP 1.1.1. In Dakota Electric’s experience, the current language of the MN DIP has not caused any application to be rejected; nor has Dakota Electric been aware of any issues related to the existing language in MN-DIP 1.1.1.

Contested item #2:

Contested item #2 regards changes to 1.1.5.1, specifically 1.1.5.1.2, where the Uniform Statewide Contract replaces the need to use the MN DIA if the condition of a DER has 40kWac or less of either *Nameplate Capacity* or *Export Capacity*. As noted in the workgroup report, Dakota Electric has significant concerns if the Commission were to conclude that *Export Capacity* shall be used in lieu of *Nameplate Capacity*. The Uniform Statewide contract utilizes the term “rated at” when describing the nature of the facilities. Dakota Electric believes that a modification to the Uniform Statewide Contract would be required if Export Capacity were to be used in 1.1.5.1.2. This is not insignificant because the language of the Uniform Statewide Contract is laid out in Minnesota Rule 7835.9910. Additionally, the Uniform Statewide Contract does not provide an adequate method for specifying the modes of operation for a DER using Export Limiting controls. Without specifying these modes of operation, Dakota Electric is concerned that we would not have adequate contractual protection if an interconnecting customer made changes to the export capacity or mode of operation for the export limiting device. These issues could inflict reliability concerns on the utility’s distribution system. Further, the Cooperative notes that issues related to the pending capacity rulemaking potentially apply for this contested item as well.

Contested item #3:

Contested item #3 regards changes to 5.14.3 and whether Export Capacity shall be specified as a limitation in the Interconnection Agreement. In Dakota Electric’s review of both positions on this contested item, there are a few clarifications that are needed.

First, both positions support the conclusion that Export Capacity should be included as a limitation in the Interconnection Agreement. Dakota Electric believes that all parties support this conclusion because it is a benefit to both the interconnection customer and

the utility to have the Export Capacity specified in some way on the Interconnection Agreement. In particular, Parties supporting Alternative A stated:

The USC does not contain any provision with regard to limiting the export of the facility at the Point of Common Coupling/Interconnection with the utility's electric system. It, however, does state "This contract contains all the agreements made between the QF and the Utility except that this contract shall at all times be subject to all rules and orders issued by the Public Utilities Commission or other government agency having jurisdiction over the subject matter of this contract." The Commission adopts changes to the MN DIP through an order. Thus, adoption of Alternative A would effectively incorporate any export capacity limitation listed in the Interconnection Application into the relevant Interconnection Agreement, both the USC and MN DIA.³

Dakota Electric notes that Alternative A relies on the Interconnection Customer specifying the Export Capacity as listed in the Interconnection Application. An Interconnection Application is a unilateral submission made by the Interconnection Customer for the purpose of initiating the utility's interconnection review process. Following submission, the application proceeds through multiple stages of technical review. As a result of these iterative studies, the utility can suggest the Interconnection Customer modify the Export Capacity assumptions provided in the initial application. For example, the utility may suggest reducing the Export Capacity to avoid a distribution system upgrade. Any Export Capacity stated in the Interconnection Application is preliminary, contingent, and subject to change based on subsequent engineering analyses and system conditions. Since the stated Export Capacity in the Interconnection Application has not been mutually agreed to by both parties, and remains unresolved at the application stage, it should not constitute a definitive or enforceable contractual term. Therefore, any agreed upon Export Capacity should be included in the *Interconnection Agreement*, which is a signed agreement by both parties, and not in the *Interconnection Application*.

Parties supporting Alternative A for contested item 3 have also discussed that “the term Interconnection Agreement included both the USC and the MN DIA.” Dakota Electric agrees that both the USC and the MN DIA are Interconnection Agreements. However, Dakota Electric is concerned that the current USC does not have a method to specify a DER’s Nameplate Capacity and its Export Capacity as well as the agreed upon Export Control Method. Dakota Electric believes that the MN DIA is the proper avenue for an Interconnection Customer and a utility to specify the Export Control Method and any modes of operation for the interconnecting DER. Dakota Electric proposed the following modification to Alternative B.

Dakota Electric Alternative B - A DER using an acceptable control method is required to execute a MN DIA, in which the Export Capacity specified in the Interconnection Agreement will subsequently be included as a limitation.

This proposal clarifies that an Export Capacity limited interconnection application shall use the MN DIA as the interconnection agreement for specifying Export Capacity. Parties in support of option A stated:

However, if Alternative B is adopted, the USC will not be able to be used by owners whose facility has a capacity of 40 kW or less at the Point of Common Coupling/Interconnection with the utility’s electric system because, as noted above, that term is not currently “included as a limitation in the” USC. Thus, adoption of Alternative B would result in a conflict with the Minn. R. 7835.6100 and 7835.9910 because use of the USC would no longer be allowed for facilities with a capacity at the Point of Common Coupling/Interconnection with the utility’s electric system of 40 kW or less simply because export limiting equipment was being used.⁴

Dakota Electric does not agree with this interpretation. Nothing in Alternative B would preclude a DER which has a capacity of 40kW or less from executing the USC. The MN DIA would be executed *in addition to* the execution of the USC and would allow an Interconnection Customer and utility to specify the terms of the Export Capacity. Minn R. 7835.6100 does not provide guidance regarding prevention of executing additional

interconnection agreements. Minn R. 7835.6100 only states that the USC is the form for use between a utility and a qualifying facility having less than 40kW of capacity.

Parties supporting Alternative A state:

Alternative B would also appear to create an internal conflict with Section 1.1.5.1 of the MN DIP because that section states that the USC “replaces the need to use the MN DIA if all of the following conditions are met and the Interconnection Customer does not request the MN DIA.”⁵

Again, Dakota Electric does not believe there is an ‘internal conflict’ as the USC would be executed if the DER’s capacity was Nameplate Capacity (contested item) of 40kW or below. The MN DIA would be executed to specify the Export Capacity and modes of operation of the DER. Dakota Electric believes the framework of MN DIP already envisions the execution of both the USC and a MN DIA because Section 1.1.5.1 states:

The Uniform Statewide Contract (Minn. R. 7835.9910) replaces the need to use the MN DIA if all of the following conditions are met **and the Interconnection Customer does not request the MN DIA (emphasis added).**⁶

If an Interconnection Customer requested, the MN DIA and USC can both be executed.

Additionally, Section 1.1.5.2 clearly states:

There may also be situations where the Interconnection Customer would need to sign both the Uniform Statewide Contract and the MN DIA...⁷

The current language of MN DIP allows both the MN DIA and USC to be used, and the Cooperative does not believe that additional modifications to Section 1.1.5 are required. However, if the Commission would like additional clarification regarding export capacity in this section, the following subpoint could be added:

Dakota Electric Proposed - 1.1.5.4 Export Capacity limited systems are required to execute a MN DIA as defined in section 5.14.3.

Should the Commission extend the temporary annual reporting on interconnection through at least 2030 by modifying the requirement in the August 13, 2018 Order (paragraph 20)? Should the Commission make any changes to these reporting requirements?

Dakota Electric recommends that the Commission extend the temporary annual reporting on interconnections through at least 2030. Alternatively, Dakota Electric would support fully implementing annual reporting on interconnections in lieu of temporary annual reporting.

Are there other issues or concerns related to this matter?

Dakota Electric is not aware of any specific other issues or concerns at this time.
