Dear Mr. Wolf:

Northern States Power Company, doing business as Xcel Energy, provides this brief Reply to the Comments submitted on November 1, 2019, by the Department of Commerce, Division of Energy Resources.

We appreciate the Department's thorough review of our Petition and agree with their recommendation to approve a 2020 RDF rate rider factor of \$0.001252. The Department's rate factor calculation incorporated two changes—first, a correction to the amount of a Higher Education (HE4-1) grant payment and second, a change to the amount of the 2019 Minnesota Office of Management and Budget (MMB) transfer, made in January 2019. We agree with both of these changes and provide additional background on the second item for purposes of a complete and transparent record.

2019 MMB Payment Amount

On January 30, 2019, we made a payment to the MMB in the amount of \$12,566,510. However, our February 11, 2019 compliance filing in Docket No. 18-628 documenting the payment inadvertently and inaccurately noted that the payment amount was \$12,556,510 (i.e., we reported that the payment to MMB was \$10,000 less than it actually was). Our error continued in our March 21, 2019

RDF rate calculation in that docket. In effect (and due to our error), this means that the rate approved by the Commission in its April 9, 2019 Order in Docket No. 18-628 allowed the Company to recover \$10,000 less than it actually spent on the 2019 MMB Payment.

In the instant filing, the Company used the actual amount of the MMB payment (\$12,566,510) to calculate its rate. Effectively, this resulted in a proposed \$10,000 true-up from the rates approved in the April 9, 2019 Order. In calculating the rate in its Comments, the Department used the number the Company had previously reported (\$12,556,510). While the Company actually did pay the additional \$10,000 to the MMB, we agree to implement the rate consistent with the Department's calculation.

To ensure the Commission's records are transparent and complete, Attachment A to this filing is a corrected compliance filing notifying the Commission of the 2019 transfer to the MMB. It is being filed concurrently in Docket No. 18-628 and is intended to replace in its entirety the February 11, 2019 compliance filing in that docket. We apologize for our error and the confusion it has caused.

Updated Estimates of RDA and Unencumbered Balance

The Department also requested that the Company provide an estimate of the RDA balance and the unencumbered Renewable Development Fund (RDF) balance as of December 31, 2019 based on the data provided in our October 1, 2019 Petition. In addition, the Department also requested that the Company provide the most up-to-date RDA balance, including any RDA-related interest payments received by MMB.

The Company provides Attachment B to this filing the estimated unencumbered RDF balance as of December 31, 2019. As is customary, we will provide the actual RDF balance as of December 31, 2019 with our next RDF Rate Rider filing.

Information on the RDA balance can be found as Attachment C to this filing. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 116C.779 subdiv. 1(a), this account is "administered by the Commissioner of management and budget." The information in Attachment C was prepared by the MMB this summer and published on August 2, 2019. It is our understanding that MMB is currently in the process of updating their forecast and will publish updated numbers in December 2019.

Northern States Power Company, doing business as Xcel Energy, submits this revised filing in compliance with the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission's December 21, 2018 Order in the above-referenced docket. Specifically, Order point 3 requires the Company to do the following:

Within 10 days of making the 2019 transfer payment to MMB, to file a letter in the current docket notifying the Commission of the transfer.

Since making our original Compliance Filing on February 11, 2019, we have identified an error in the dollar amount that we reported as being transferred to MMB. We confirm that the actual payment that should have been reported in our February 11, 2019 Compliance Filing (and was transferred to MMB) is \$12,566,510, **not** the \$12,556,510 as stated in our February 11, 2019 Compliance Filing.
