Should the Commission approve Great Plains' proposed demand entitlement levels and cost changes? (PUC: **Ubani**)

Approved demand entitlement levels and cost changes.

* G002/M-20-633 Northern States Power Company, d/b/a Xcel Energy In the Matter of the Petition by Northern States Power Company for Approval of Changes in Contract Demand Entitlements.

- Should the Commission approve Otter Tail Power Company's Petition for its renewal of four-year customer eligibility and annual update to its Energy-Intensive, Trade-Exposed (EITE) Rider Surcharge Rate?
- 2. Should the Commission approve Otter Tail's baseline and annual update to its EITE Rider? (PUC: Larson)

Extended EITE discount four years with conditions.

- 2. Should the Commission grant the exemptions request by Minnesota Power?
- Should the Commission vary Minnesota Rule 7829.2500, subpart 6? (PUC: Kaluzniak)
