COMMENTS OF THE METROPOLITAN EMERGENCY SERVICES BOARD

The Metropolitan Emergency Services Board (MESB) has reviewed the Facilities Based 911 Plan Update filed by Charter Fiberlink CC VIII, LLC on September 14, 2016.

The Facilities Based 911 Plan Update of Charter Fiberlink CC VIII, LLC filed on September 14, 2016, satisfactorily addresses the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission's rules, Ch. 7812.0550, as they relate to the integration into the existing metro area 911 network for subscribers of Charter Fiberlink CC VIII, LLC.

The MESB's determination is based solely on a review of the Facilities Based 911 Plan filed by Charter Fiberlink CC VIII, LLC on September 14, 2016, and is subject to change if any of the information contained in said Plan is later found to be incorrect or incomplete. Once approved, should there be any changes to methods, operations or procedures described in the 911 Plan, or other significant alterations, Charter Fiberlink CC VIII, LLC is requested to file, by amendment, notification of those changes to the Commission, the State of Minnesota and the Metropolitan Emergency Services Board. The Board requests that, once approved, Charter Fiberlink CC VIII, LLC file, at a minimum, an update to their 911 Plan at least on an annual basis, and no later than June 1 of each calendar year.
