The bill credits are funded by a monthly surcharge on every wireline access line in the state. The Commission has most recently considered these matters in Dockets No. CI-16-302, CI- 15-535, CI-14-470, CI-13-213, and CI-12-182.

On September 14, 2017, the Commission's TAP Administrator submitted a report on the Fund's status in this docket.
