- I. What action should the Commission take on SMMPA's filing?
  - A. Accept SMMPA's 2014-2028 IRP <u>maintaining the IRP's base case scenario for DSM energy savings</u>.
  - B. Accept SMMPA's 2014-2028 IRP adjusting the IRP to reflect annual energy savings of approximately 1.5 percent of retail sales.
  - BC. Do not accept SMMPA's 2014-2028 IRP.
  - € D. Take no action on SMMPA's 2014-2028 IRP.
- II. What date should the Commission designate for the filing of SMMPA's next resource plan?
  - A. Establish a date based on a consensus of the parties.
  - B. Require SMMPA to file its next resource plan no later than two years from the date of the Commission's Order in this matter.
  - C. Require SMMPA to file its next resource plan no later than December 1, 2017.
  - D. Require SMMPA to file its next resource plan no later than December 1, 2017 and conditioned upon SMMPA filing the following status updates in a compliance filings by December 1, 2016:
    - a) SMMPA shall file a status update on its <u>Its</u> demand side management efforts by <del>December 1, 2016</del>;
    - b) SMMPA shall file a status update on its <u>Its</u> distributed generation efforts by December 1, 2016;
    - c) SMMPA shall file a status update on the <u>The</u> effect of federal environmental regulations by December 1, 2016.
  - E. Require SMMPA to file its next resource plan no later than December 1, 2016.
  - F. Require SMMPA to file its next resource plan no later than December 1, 2015.

## Recommendation

Staff recommends that the Commission adopt alternative numbers I.A and II. D. a, b, and c.
