As requested by Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) staff, the Minnesota Solar Energy Industries Association (MnSEIA) submits its preferred Decision Options regarding the above-referenced docket..

MnSEIA supports Decision Options 1, 3, 6, and 8. In addition, MnSEIA supports new Decision Option 9, or something similar to it, filed by CURE, which stated:

9. Before any referral to a contested case hearing and prior to concluding an expedited investigation, refer the issue of interconnection barriers to tribal clean energy development in rural areas to the Tribal Advocacy Council on Energy, so that TACE may provide guidance on issues germane to all tribes that may help to contextualize the dispute at issue in this complaint.
