Attached are the comments of the Minnesota Department of Commerce (Department) in the following matter:

Joint Request of the Detroit Lakes Public Utilities and Lake Region Electric Cooperative to Modify Electric Service Territory Boundaries

The petition was filed by Spencer Fane LLP, on behalf of Detroit Lakes Public Utilities (Detroit Lakes) and Lake Region Electric Cooperative (Lake Region), on February 28, 2025.

The filing constitutes a joint request on behalf of Detroit Lakes and Lake Region (collectively, the Parties) to update the official service territory map to reflect an agreed-upon permanent boundary change. The proposed update will impact one 10.6-acre area located within the city limit of the City of Detroit Lakes and within Lake Region's service territory. The change, if approved, will transfer electric service territory from Lake Region to Detroit Lakes, and will allow Detroit Lakes to continue to serve one commercial customer.

The Department recommends the Commission approve the joint request for the agreed-upon permanent boundary change from Lake Region to Detroit Lakes Public Utilities and requests MNGEO update the service territory map, to reflect the changes on the map as provided. The Department is available to answer any questions the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission may have.
