SUPPLEMENTAL COMMENTS

INTRODUCTION

Northern States Power Company, doing business as Xcel Energy, submits these Supplemental Comments to the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission in response to January 9, 2026 Reply Comments from Cooperative Energy Future (CEF), the Environmental Law and Policy Center (ELPC), Vote Solar, the Institute for Local Self-Reliance, and Solar United Neighbors (“CEF/ELPC et al.”) and Fresh Energy regarding the Company’s proposal for Phase 2 of Capacity*Connect (C*C), a Distributed Capacity Procurement (DCP) program.

With these Supplemental Comments, we outline an option for the Commission, in direct response to stakeholder recommendations that Phase 2 includes specific, focused measurement of potential distribution benefits of distributed battery energy storage systems (BESS). To the extent the Commission wants the Company to dedicate a portion of C*C Phase 2 to these learnings, we propose to develop a plan for a small number of assets to be sited and operated solely to seek and evaluate distribution benefits and not participate in the Midcontinent Independent System Operator (MISO) market. We discuss this distribution-only concept further below.

We also discuss why it is premature to require a behind-the-meter distributed power plant and agree with Fresh Energy and CEF/ELPC et al. that to the extent the Commission wants to investigate such a program – a separate docket is the best place to do that. To that end, we provide as Attachment A, an outline of our existing demand response and distributed generation programs that will be important to consider in concert with a potential new BTM VPP, as will market factors like MISO’s load-modifying resource (LMR) reforms.

We also briefly respond to Fresh Energy’s recommendations regarding the Interim Program Assessment and reiterate our commitment to file a full Evaluation Plan within 180 days of Commission Order.

Finally, as mentioned in the Company’s January 9, 2026 Reply Comments, we met with the Company’s Environmental Justice Advisory Board (EJAB) on January 13. These Supplemental Comments include a brief summary of the meeting and feedback received.

I. DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM VALUE, SITING CRITERIA, AND USE CASES

As we continue refining our approach to siting and operating the C*C BESS assets, our objective remains to maximize customer value while advancing learning about both bulk and distribution system benefits. The following section outlines our response to Fresh Energy’s Reply Comments recommendations by clarifying how distribution system value can be incorporated into Phase 2 through refined siting criteria, appropriate use of reliability and investment information, and targeted analysis of interactions with existing distributed energy resources (DER). We also address stakeholder interest in a distribution-only use case and offer a new distribution-only carve-out as an option for the Commission, which could support focused learning while maintaining the core intent of Phase 2.

A. Distribution System Value and Siting Criteria

We appreciate Fresh Energy’s constructive Reply Comments and support for the Company’s proposal. We agree with Fresh Energy’s helpful distinction of distribution benefits as either coincident benefits or active benefits. The Company can realize coincident distribution benefits while operating BESS assets for bulk system benefit in Phase 2. Active benefits would require the Company to operate the C*C assets specifically to deliver value to the distribution system. Today as we have proposed for C*C Phase 2, we do not have the capability to operate the C*C assets specifically to deliver value to the distribution system *while also participating in the MISO market*, because the assets must be available when MISO calls on them. As we have stated previously, however, we still believe that there are coincident distribution benefits of C*C operated in this manner, and we will seek to measure and study those benefits.

Fresh Energy recommends that the Company “consider secondary siting criteria that maximize its ability to learn from Phase II of the program while it focuses on delivering bulk system benefits. While siting decisions would be primarily driven by

bulk system needs, these secondary criteria would be used to ensure the Company targets a range of feeders with characteristics that could allow the resources to be actively managed.”

We appreciate Fresh Energy’s suggestions. First, we clarify that specific siting decisions for C*C will *not* be primarily driven by bulk system needs, because in this case, bulk system needs can be met largely regardless of location; indeed, the value of Capacity*Connect over a large grid-scale battery is its ability to also provide distribution and other value through strategic siting on the distribution system. Fresh Energy specifically recommends – based off the Department of Commerce’s Comments – that the Company “add secondary siting criteria that maximize its ability to learn from Phase II. This should include siting, where possible, based on:

- [1] Identified reliability issues.
- [2] Deferred transmission and distribution investment opportunities.
- [3] Locations with high penetrations of DERs, grid congestion, and/or Daytime Minimum Load [DML] issues.”¹

We appreciate the permissive nature of this recommendation, which provides important flexibility for the Company as we implement this novel program and learn as we go.

We do not object to criterion #1 but reiterate that Capacity*Connect will not have a demonstrable or direct impact on improving reliability or resilience at the feeder, tap, or customer level because it will not be designed to island such that an individual BESS could provide backup power in the case of an outage. That said, it is possible to utilize reliability metrics to inform siting criteria, and we do not object to using reliability results as an input where possible. As siting, deployment, and operations progress, we will revisit siting criteria – including whether using reliability metrics provides value in terms of siting – and adjust along the way, providing updates as needed in our quarterly progress reports.

Regarding criterion #2, we can consider siting – where possible – based on deferred distribution investment opportunities. We agree there may be value in siting C*C assets in locations where a future distribution investment may be planned, and we can agree to use distribution investment information as an additional siting criterion where possible. However, Fresh Energy’s recommended criterion #2 also references deferred *transmission* opportunities; while there may be some transmission benefits, due to the scale of these assets relative to the transmission system, we would not anticipate those benefits to be substantial or defer an investment. With the goal of

starting simple in mind, we suggest it is premature at best to consider transmission investment deferral opportunities in the context of C*C deployment.

Regarding criterion #3, this approach would require additional specificity due to potential system risks and risks to interconnection customers. First, we want to be clear that we will not site BESS where there are existing Generation Hosting Capacity constraints. We will not allow these BESS to be sited, built, or operated without maintaining compliance with the various requirements that are applied to all other DER. For this reason, if we were to site a BESS in an area with existing constraints, we would need to mitigate the risks that the installation would cause on the system, which would slow implementation and increase costs, potentially substantially. These are negative impacts that subtract from the benefit of implementing C*C. For these reasons, we will not site any C*C project where there are existing constraints or where a mitigation would be required for safe and reliable interconnection. Instead, we commit to provide an analysis of the interaction of BESS that could be sited on feeders or substations with DER. To do this, we will aim to analyze a portion of locations on substation transformers with at least 2 MW of DER and at least one analysis on a substation transformer with at least 15 MW of DER. In our Interim Program Assessment, we will explain our analysis and learnings toward meeting this objective and learning about the interaction of the existing DER and the BESS – without introducing constraints or negative impacts. Depending on the analysis, we could then provide our recommendation for including this additional siting criteria on a go-forward basis.

B. New Option – Distribution-Only Concept

In addition to the expanded siting criteria and targets discussed above, we understand that parties are interested in distribution-specific use cases – i.e., siting and operating the BESS for distribution benefit instead of participating in MISO markets. We understand that part of the goal of this use case would be to more directly, and in isolation, explore and evaluate the distribution benefits of distributed BESS.

As we explained in our Reply Comments, we believe that the core of the DCP concept is bulk system value for the benefit of all customers. That said, we also understand stakeholders' desire to isolate learnings through a distribution-specific use case. We continue to believe that Phase 2 should remain focused on the bulk system use case, and that we can and will measure distribution impacts and benefits even as the BESS are operated for the bulk system. However, in response to stakeholder feedback, as an option for the Commission to consider, we can agree to dedicate a small carve out of C*C BESS assets to focus on realizing distribution system value if the Commission chooses. As stated in our Petition and Reply Comments,

Capacity*Connect is not meant to be a non-wires alternative (NWA) program that would fully address a capacity need and defer a planned future distribution system investment or provide reliability benefits; however, BESS can still provide distribution system benefits, so this small tranche of distribution-only assets would, as recommended by stakeholders, seek to isolate those benefits for learning purposes.

Operational learning objectives of the distribution-only concept would include:

- What are the operational, resource, and process changes needed to maximize distribution value?
- What additional safety risk do BESS pose to employees and the public?
- How do different charging and discharging times affect the feeder and substation transformers?
- How does the reliability and longevity of batteries compare to standard upgrade solutions?
- Are distribution-only batteries cost beneficial for customers?
- What size, location, and quantity of batteries on a distribution feeder optimizes feeder loading and operations?

To prepare for this distribution-only concept and refine our learning objectives, the Company needs to undertake additional engineering analysis to determine how many megawatts and sites could be beneficial, and at what locations. In addition, we would need to build additional operational capabilities within our distribution control center to operate the BESS safely and effectively. Given the need for additional analysis and preparation, if the Commission elects a small distribution-only sub-deployment, we anticipate that those BESS assets would be deployed in the second half of the 2026-2028 deployment period. We can agree to reserve this to-be-determined small number of assets for distribution-only operations for at least two full years, at which point we would complete an analysis of benefits. If sufficient benefits are not realized, we would revisit whether market participation would be a more cost-effective use of these assets for our customers. By that time, DER aggregation markets to comply with Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) Order 2222 may be available, providing another market participation option.

Because the customer benefit of these BESS may be lower than the bulk-system-focused use case we originally proposed, siting the distribution-focused assets at Xcel Energy sites – instead of at customer locations – would reduce costs by avoiding site acquisition expenses and lease payments, so we would propose to broaden the siting criterion for the distribution-only portion to include Xcel Energy-owned locations. As part of our analysis to determine the best locations, we would explore whether Xcel

Energy has available property near identified feeders and consider those potential cost savings in determining the total size of the distribution-only sub-deployment.

We commit to making a compliance filing in this docket within one year of Commission approval outlining our supplemental analysis and conclusions regarding the size and deployment timeline for the distribution-only sub-deployment and provide more detail on our learning objectives and evaluation plan.

Below, we provide a timeline for the analysis, measurement & verification, and reporting we have committed to in this proceeding.

II. REQUIRING A BEHIND-THE-METER DISTRIBUTED/VIRTUAL POWER PLANT PROGRAM IS PREMATURE

CEF/ELPC et al. recommend the Commission require Xcel Energy to work with stakeholders to develop a behind-the-meter (BTM) distributed power plant (DPP) program for low-income customers by July 1, 2026.² Fresh Energy noted that “the Commission could open a separate docket for the purpose of developing a behind-the-meter virtual power plant (VPP) program. If the Commission chooses to do this, [the Company] should be required to submit compliance filings reporting on the progress of the Colorado [Aggregator Virtual Power Plant (AVPP)] program and its relevance to Minnesota.”³

We appreciate these actionable recommendations. We particularly appreciate CEF/ELPC’s recommendation to focus the program to provide benefits to income qualified customers. While we continue to believe it is premature to require the creation of a BTM program, and a separate docket is not necessary, we understand that many commenters would like to see a new BTM third-party VPP/DPP program. At the same time, we already have many DER programs – including distributed generation (DG) programs and incentives, and a suite of demand response (DR) and energy efficiency programs and pilots through our Energy Conservation and Optimization (ECO) portfolio. Income qualified customers can and are encouraged to participate in these many offerings – they are also often provided increased incentives. Attachment A provides a list of our existing programs. Notably, the Company has recently launched AC Rewards for multifamily buildings and will be launching Battery Connect later in 2026. Additionally, we will be moving our Peak Flex Credit program, which includes an aggregation option, in our next ECO Triennial plan.

The 2027-2029 ECO Triennial plan is in development and will be filed on June 1, 2026. Any new BTM program must be considered in the context of our existing options within and outside of ECO, and in alignment with customer and system needs. This holistic view is necessary to ensure we are strategic about potential market overlap, system and customer needs, achieving Minnesota's policy goals, and keeping customer bills as low as possible.

Further, MISO is in the process of various reforms to its load-modifying resource (LMR) markets and requirements. MISO's Demand Response and Emergency Resources Reforms (ER25-1886) filed on April 4, 2025 is still pending at FERC. It has an anticipated effective date of Planning Year 2028-2029. Key elements of this proposal include participation options, measurement and verification baseline methodology, accreditation, real-time availability, and MISO-initiated testing.

The LMR Testing Rules proposal (ER25-2845) was filed on July 14, 2025 and was accepted by FERC. The changes went into effect on July 15, 2025. These reforms include new testing requirements for Demand Resources participating in the Planning Resource Auction.

The LMR Penalties proposal is anticipated to be filed by MISO at FERC in the first quarter of 2026, with a proposed effective date of June 1, 2026. The key elements include updates to non-performance penalties. Currently, LMRs are subject to a real-time penalty and potential disqualification for being unavailable. Under MISO's proposal, the real-time performance penalty will continue to apply, but a claw-back of auction revenues will be added. Penalties and potential disqualification will be based on criteria for partial and complete failures.

The impact of these reforms on our demand response portfolio could be significant, and we are still evaluating those potential impacts as the stakeholder and FERC regulatory processes continue.⁴

For these reasons, it is premature to require the Company to develop a BTM VPP/DPP program, but to the extent the Commission wants to investigate such a program – a separate docket is the best place to do that in order to fully consider potential new options while accounting for a variety of considerations like whether or how solar could be included, given limitations on solar as part of ECO; income-qualified program requirements; market overlap with existing programs, given limitations on dual participation in ECO programs; control strategies for demand

response alongside MISO requirements, as noted above; location of specific resources that can benefit the grid; and lessons learned from the Colorado AVPP experience.

III. INTERIM PROGRAM ASSESSMENT AND EVALUATION PLAN

Fresh Energy recommends – in alignment with CEF/ELPC et al.’s Initial Comments that the Company include the following in its Interim Program Assessment:

- Discussion of how DERMS dispatch decisions reflect tradeoffs between bulk and distribution system benefits.
- The extent to which concurrent benefit streams were realized in Phase 2.
- Analysis of the alignment between MISO dispatch requirements and dispatch for distribution system value, understanding the Company is not expecting to dispatch these assets for distribution system value in Phase 2.
- Detailed discussion of the Company’s experience siting C*C assets.

In our Reply Comments, we committed to filing an Evaluation Plan within 180 days of a Commission Order in this docket, as recommended by the Department. The Evaluation Plan will include a more detailed description of the Interim Program Assessment and its contents. While we do not object to including these items in our Interim Program Assessment, the Evaluation Plan will provide a more fulsome view of the Company’s plan for the Interim Program Assessment. We will consider these items when developing the Evaluation Plan.

IV. ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE ADVISORY BOARD FEEDBACK

As mentioned in our Reply Comments, representatives from the Company and Sparkfund met with interested members of the Company’s Environmental Justice Advisory Board (EJAB) on January 13, 2026. Because the EJAB is focused on energy efficiency programs and workforce development, this meeting was an additional, optional meeting. Four members of EJAB joined the meeting. We provided an overview of our Capacity*Connect proposal and how we are embedding equity and environmental justice into the program. We discussed the site selection process and our plan that customers in EJ areas, certified businesses, and community organizations will have the first opportunity to serve as site hosts and benefit from site host payments and ongoing engagement with the Company. We also explained how we believe that the process of outreach and marketing to potential site hosts will provide an important opportunity to build relationships with these customers and communities and hear directly from them about their needs and priorities. We noted that we believe it is premature to set targets for a specific percentage of host payments or sites located in EJ areas, at certified businesses, or community organizations.

One EJAB member expressed support for the siting plan overall. EJAB members had questions about aesthetics of the BESS assets at the sites. We explained that we want to work closely with customer site hosts on beautification, because each site and customer may need or desire something different. While we have considered site beautification as part of our overall deployment planning, it was helpful to hear from EJAB that this may be a bigger focus, and we will commit to including aesthetics and beautification in materials and discussions with potential site hosts. A member also had a question regarding how we will protect safety at the site and in communities. We emphasized that safety is a core value for Xcel Energy, and we will procure and construct the sites according to established safety standards, including constructing concrete enclosures for the BESS at each site, installing fire safety measures and real-time monitoring of the C*C assets, and complying with local permitting requirements. We will also work with local first responders to ensure they are aware of and trained on responding to possible (but unlikely) fires. Safety will be a key topic in conversations with potential site hosts as well as communities.

One EJAB member cautioned that new programs like Capacity*Connect, while potentially beneficial to host sites, can also create division in communities if benefits are seen to flow only to the host sites. With this in mind, potential site hosts should be encouraged to do their own community engagement, working with partners trusted in the community.

We provided an overview of the initial plan for competitive procurement and ensuring that certified businesses have the opportunity to participate as vendors for Capacity*Connect and noted that we are still working on the procurement plan details in collaboration with Sparkfund. EJAB asked what kinds of opportunities may be available for contracting, and we explained that we anticipate construction and engineering work will be available, but we are still working on the details. Overall, we estimate that approximately 80 percent of the Capacity*Connect program budget will be competitively sourced, and within those sourcing plans, there will be significant opportunity for subcontracting to certified businesses even if the C*C prime contractors (e.g., engineering/procurement/construction or EPC contractors) are not themselves certified businesses. We have committed to prioritize and incentivize subcontracting with certified businesses in C*C procurements. We committed to providing more information to EJAB about supplier opportunities as they become available.

One EJAB member wondered if we have materials to share that explain the benefits of the program to customers and communities. We agreed to follow up with our current fact sheet and provide additional materials as they become available. We

appreciate the feedback that all outreach and communications materials must speak to the benefits of C*C to communities.

We appreciate the engagement and feedback from EJAB. An EJAB member suggested a separate equity-focused committee focused on Capacity*Connect, as Fresh Energy suggested in Initial Comments. The Company is not opposed to creating such a committee if the Commission feels this is warranted, but as noted in our Reply Comments, we believe working through existing advisors – including EJAB, whose mission is to advise the Company on equity and environmental justice initiatives – is more appropriate to the scale and targeted deployment for Capacity*Connect. We offered to provide updates and engage EJAB on Capacity*Connect as much as they would like.

CONCLUSION

We have developed a streamlined, beneficial Phase 2 that starts simple – with the aim to build over time. We have considered stakeholder recommendations and made some adjustments that align with our imperative to serve all customers safely and reliably while keeping bills as low as possible. We are now putting forward another option for the Commission to consider – a distribution-only sub-deployment – in response to stakeholder feedback. We appreciate the strong interest in Capacity*Connect and look forward to working with stakeholders and sharing our lessons learned from Phases 1 and 2 as we build the grid of the future for our customers.

We respectfully request the Commission approve:

- Implementation of Capacity*Connect Phase 2 as a learning phase, including:
 - Deployment of approximately 50-200 MW of Company-owned and -operated distribution-interconnected BESS by the end of 2028.
 - A budget range of approximately \$152 million (corresponding to the planned 50 MW deployment) to approximately \$430 million (estimated for a 200 MW deployment) through 2028.
 - Implementation of a limited deployment of a grid distributed energy resources management system (DERMS).
- The Company's proposal to seek recovery of C*C costs in the Renewable Energy Standard (RES) Rider.
- The following additional filings related to analysis, measurement and verification, and reporting:
 - 2026
 - Three months after Commission Order:

- Begin filing quarterly reports (see Attachment A to the Company's Reply Comments), continuing at least until the Interim Program Assessment
 - Within six months of Commission Order:
 - File Capacity*Connect Evaluation Plan
- 2027
 - Within one year of Commission Order:
 - File initial analysis, evaluation plan, and next steps on distribution-only sub-deployment, if the Commission prefers
 - November 1, 2027:
 - Include development of NSPM-specific distribution benefit value with our 2027 Integrated Distribution Plan (IDP).
- 2028
 - No later than two years after Commission approval:
 - File Interim Program Assessment, including measurement and verification (M&V) from a third-party consultant, to be filed after commercial operation of 20 MW or two years from Phase 2 approval, whichever is sooner.
- 2029/2030 (estimated)
 - After distribution-only assets have been online for at least two years:
 - File evaluation of distribution-only sub-deployment performance and benefits.

Table A-1: Xcel Energy Demand Response and Distributed Generation Offerings and Initiatives¹

Program Name	Description
AC*Rewards	AC Rewards seeks to reduce AC load during demand peaks. Participants can receive up-front rebates for enrolling a qualifying thermostat, and receive annual bill credits, in exchange for allowing the Company to temporarily adjust the set point on the thermostat during control events. Currently, certain thermostats from Honeywell, Ecobee, Nest, and Sensi are eligible for enrollment. Residential and small business customers can participate. AC*Rewards has approximately 50,000 participants. (Docket No. E,G002/CIP-23-92)
Behavioral Demand Response (Also known as Energy Action Days)	BDR is a mechanism to reach out to residential customers asking them to voluntarily reduce load during peak times. It does not require specific enrolled equipment for the customer, or control equipment by the Company. Messages are sent to customers with an active email address, approximately 500,000. (Docket No. E,G002/CIP-23-92)
Electric Rate Savings (A23, A24, A27 Rates)	The Electric Rate Savings (Peak Control) program is offered to any business customer who can reduce their electric loads during control periods by at least 50 kW during a summer month. In return for being on-call to reduce their electric loads and curtailing load during a control event, they receive a monthly discount on their demand charges. Participants save as much as 50 percent on demand charges over the year. Electric Rate Savings participants are served with our Peak Controlled Service and Peak Controlled Time of Day Service tariffs. Further discounts are available for also controlling loads when energy costs are high, though our Tier 1 Energy Controlled Rider tariff. Approximately 1,800 customers participate in the program. (Docket No. E,G002/CIP-23-92)
Peak Partner Rewards	The Peak Partner Rewards program is offered to any business customer that can reduce their electric load during control periods by at least 25 kW between June and September. With Peak Partner Rewards, customers can receive credits on electric bills for agreeing to reduce electric usage during periods of peak energy demand, such as hot summer days. Customers will receive additional bill credits when they reduce their electric usage by their agreed upon amount or more during control periods. Approximately 85 customers participate. (Docket No. E,G002/CIP-23-92)
Saver's Switch (Residential and Commercial Air Conditioning and Water Heating Rider)	Saver's Switch® is a load management program available to electric customers (residential and small business) with central air conditioning. Participating customers receive a monthly discount on their June through September bills. In exchange for the discounts, participants allow Xcel Energy to cycle their air conditioner on and off during control events, which typically occur on hot, humid summer days. Air conditioners are controlled via a radio operated switch installed by a licensed electrician on or near the customer's air conditioner. Approximately 400,000 customers participate. (Docket No. E,G002/CIP-23-92)
EV Optimization Pilot	This pilot will study the management of the grid impacts of electric vehicles by working with residential and commercial customers to provide schedule options for their daily EV charging. The schedule options ensure charging occurs outside the

Program Name	Description
