Response:

The two options – both with and without the proposed transfer, would not be treated any differently than any other Attachment O project that OTP has, just different values of the project. With the transfer, the amount included in Attachment O would be the net remaining cost (OTP cost less payment from MPC) of OTP's ownership share. Without the transfer being allowed, it would increase the cost for our customers and give MPC customers a benefit without them paying anything for it.
