# COMMENTS OF THE MINNESOTA DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE

DIVISION OF ENERGY RESOURCES E294, E145/SA-16-1034

#### I. SUMMARY OF PROPOSAL

On December 9, 2016, Preston Public Utilities (Municipal) and Tri-County Electric Cooperative (Cooperative), collectively the Parties, jointly filed a petition under Minn. Stat. 216B.39, subd.3, asking the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) to modify the Parties' service territory boundaries. Approval of the Parties' request would permanently transfer the Affected Area from Tri-County Electric Cooperative to Preston Public Utilities.

#### II. DEPARTMENT ANALYSIS

#### A. VETERAN'S CEMETERY PARCEL

Exhibit A-1 to the Petition is a boundary map with a three-page legal boundary description of the four separate parcels (A, B, E and F) in Fillmore County that will be transferred to Preston Public Utilities. With the Cooperative's written consent, the Municipal has been providing interim service during the planning stages of the project. The Southeastern Minnesota Veterans Cemetery project is being designed to honor veterans and encompasses approximately 176 acres.

#### B. GEHLING PROPERTY PARCEL

Exhibit A-2 to the Petition is a boundary map with a two-page legal boundary description of the two separate parcels (one being approximately 6.15 acres and the other being approximately 1.86 acres) in Fillmore County that will be transferred to Preston Public Utilities. With the Cooperative's written consent, the Municipal has been providing interim service during the construction of this area. This property includes one customer with multiple service meters.

The Department notes that the Parties have agreed upon appropriate compensation.

Thus, the Department agrees that the Parties' request to establish the Affected Area as part of Preston Public Utilities service area is consistent with Minn. Stat. 216B.39.

The Minnesota Department of Commerce, Division of Energy Resources (Department) recommends that the Commission approve the requested service territory transfer from Tri-County Cooperative to Preston Public Utilities.
