Greater Minnesota Gas, Inc. (“GMG”) filed its 2014 Annual Automatic Adjustment Report (“AAA”) and its Purchased Gas Adjustment True-Up Filing (“True-Up”) on August 28, 2014. The Minnesota Department of Commerce, Division of Energy Resources (“the Department”) filed its Review of the utilities’ annual reports on May 5, 2015. This letter serves as GMG’s Reply, in lieu of filing Reply Comments.

GMG appreciates the Department’s recommendation that the Commission accept its True-Up and allow it to implement its true-up as reflected in its AAA.

The Department requested that utilities respond to a series of questions regarding interruptible customers that habitually fail to curtail gas use when requested. GMG has not experienced that problem. Most of GMG’s interruptible customers do not use gas during the heating season, given the nature of their businesses. GMG only has two interruptible customers that use gas during the heating season, which are schools, and they have complied with curtailment requests. Accordingly, GMG does not believe that it has sufficient experience with the issue raised by the Department to provide meaningful insight; and, GMG therefore respectfully declines to offer discussion in that regard.
