

The Commission met on **Tuesday, October 1, 2019**, with Chair Sieben and Commissioners Lipschultz, Means, Schuerger, and Tuma present.

The following matters were taken up by the Commission:

**PL-9/CN-14-916**

**In the Matter of the Application of Enbridge Energy, Limited Partnership for a Certificate of Need for the Proposed Line 3 Replacement Project in Minnesota from the North Dakota Border to the Wisconsin Border**

**PL-9/PPL-15-137**

**In the Matter of the Application of Enbridge Energy, Limited Partnership for a Route Permit for the Proposed Line 3 Replacement Project in Minnesota from the North Dakota Border to the Wisconsin Border**

Commissioner Lipschultz moved that the Commission:

1. Request the Minnesota Department of Commerce Division of Energy Environmental Review and Analysis to revise the final EIS to include an analysis of the potential impact of an oil spill into the Lake Superior watershed consistent with the Court of Appeals's decision, and to submit a revised final EIS to the Commission within 60 days.
2. Delegate to the Executive Secretary authority to issue a notice requesting comments concerning the revised final EIS and to set appropriate comment time frames consistent with Minnesota rules.

The motion passed 5 – 0.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
