Dear Mr. Wolf:

I represent the City of Staples, municipal corporation that operates a municipal utility under Minnesota law ("Staples"), which is authorized, on behalf of itself and Minnesota Power ("MP") (collectively, the "Parties"), to make this filing.

# Summary of the Joint Request

This filing constitutes the Parties' joint request under Minn. Stat. § 216B.39, subd. 3, that the MPUC modify the Parties' service territory boundaries. This joint request concerns the permanent transfer of an area within the city limits of the City of Staples and within the electric service territory assigned to MP (the "Affected Area"), as further described below.

#### Legal Authorities

By statute, "the commission may on its own or at the request of an electric utility make changes in the boundaries of the assigned service areas, but only after notice and hearing . . . " Minn. Stat. § 216B.39, subd. 3. In addition, "no electric utility shall render or extend electric service at retail within the assigned service area of another electric

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utility unless the electric utility consents thereto in writing . . . " Minn. Stat. § 216B.40 (2014). In the present case, the Parties seek to adjust the service territory boundaries to permanently transfer the Affected Area to Staples' assigned service territory. The Parties have agreed upon appropriate compensation. The Parties request that the Commission update its official records as to electric service territory boundaries.

## **Underlying Information**

1. <u>Exhibit A: Affected Area.</u> Attached as Exhibit A is a map and legal description that depict the boundaries of the Affected Area. The Affected Area involves approximately 60.67 acres. The Parties have agreed to the terms and conditions for the transfer of the Affected Area, including compensation provisions, after arms-length negotiations. The Affected Area currently contains three customers: one large commercial customer and two utility account customers.

The Parties mutually determined the optimal transition date of December 1, 2016 for technical ease and to minimize customer disruption. The Parties plan to complete the transfer of service providers on that date.

The Parties acknowledge that the Commission wishes to direct separate notice to customers as to the pending proceeding before the Commission. Attached as <u>Exhibit</u> B is a proposed notice to be sent to all customers in the Affected Area.

## **EXHIBIT A - MAP AND LEGAL DESCRIPTION**

## Parcel I (Riggs)

That part of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter, Section 8, Township 133, Range 32 West of the 5th Principal Meridian described as follows:


Beginning at the point on the Northerly right of way line for Trunk Highway Number 10 where a line 33 feet Westerly of and parallel with the North South Quarter line of said Section 8 intersects said right of way line (said highway right of way line being the line 75 feet Northeasterly of the center line described in the final certificate recorded in Book 9 of Miscellaneous, Page 272) thence North 303.5 feet along said line parallel with the North South Quarter line of Section 8, thence West 235 feet, thence South 300.0 feet, more or less to the Northerly line of said highway right of way (previously described), and thence Southeasterly along said highway right of way line to the place of beginning.

Except the Southeasterly 75 feet thereof which was taken by decree set out in final certificate dated November 14, 1967 and recorded as Instrument No. 242663 in the office of the Register of Deeds for Todd County.

Subject to the site corner as set aside for the highway right of way in the instrument as recorded in Book 9 of Miscellaneous, Page 272.

## Parcel II (Logering)

All that part of the East Half of the Northwest Quarter (E 1/2 of NW 1/4) of Section 8, Township 133 N, Range 32 W lying northerly of the northerly right of way line of U.S. Highway No. 10 except the following described tract: Beginning at the point on the northerly right of way line for U.S. Highway No. 10 where a line 33 feet westerly of and parallel with the north-south quarter line of said Section 8 intersects said right of way line (said highway right of way line being the line 75 feet northeasterly of the centerline described in the final certificate recorded in Book 9 of Miscellaneous, Page 272); thence North 303.5 feet along said line parallel with the north-south quarter line of Section 8; thence West 235 feet; thence South 300 feet, more-or less, to the northerly line of said highway right of way; thence southeasterly along said highway right of way line to the point of beginning, except the southeasterly 75 feet thereof taken by decree set forth in final certificate dated November 14, 1967 and recorded as Instrument No. 242663, and subject to site corner as set aside for highway right of way, and subject to cartway or roadway on east boundary line.
