On April 10, 2020 the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") issued a Notice Comment Period ("Notice") in Docket No. E-999/M-17-123. In the Notice the Commission provides topics open for comment specific to the Department of Commerce ("Department") Energy Environmental Review and Analysis's ("EERA") filing Recommendations on Review of Solar and Wind Decommissioning Plans submitted on March 16, 2020. The recommendations are in response to a report submitted to the Commission on August 31, 2018 by the Department-convened stakeholder Solar and Wind Decommissioning Working Group. Tom Donofrio, Director of Project Development and Reporting for Minnesota Power (or the "Company") was one of 12 participants in this working group that met between April 2017 and January 2018.

Minnesota Power reviewed the recommendations of the EERA and supports the proposed order and timeline for reviewing open wind and solar dockets, as well as procedures for reviewing decommissioning plans. Additionally, the Company has no additional topics it feels should be addressed in a decommission plan.
