Xcel coal plants produced more electricity during several hours of polar vortex than MISO wind fleet.

Wind generated energy severely dropped during a polar plunge and the coal plant filled in the need. We need to keep the coal generation plant for when wind energy cannot meet demand. We need a reliable energy grid with MN self-sufficiently.
