The Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (DNR) has reviewed the site permit application for the Louise Solar project. Our agency offers the following comments and recommendations.

Security Fencing

Section 5.0 of the site permit application references a fencing design described in the DNR's *Commercial Solar Siting Guidance*. Our agency would like to clarify that this guidance document, including fencing recommendations, is being updated to reflect current best practices and specifications. As such, our agency cautions that a 6-foot fence is not high enough to exclude deer and placing smooth strand wire on top of a 6-foot fence may result in entanglement. An 8-foot fence would exclude most deer, although some deer may be able to clear the fence. Deer that jump the fence may not be able to jump back out, thus becoming trapped within the solar facility. In this scenario, deer egress areas in the fencing design could allow deer a safe exit. To ensure complete deer exclusion from the solar facility, the *DNR's Fencing Handbook For 10 ft Woven Wire Deer Exclusion Fence* recommends 10-foot fencing.

Vegetation Management Plan

Our agency understands that the applicant is revising the Vegetation Management Plan, submitted with the site permit application, based on the *Guidance for Developing a Vegetation Establishment and Management Plan for Solar Facilities*. It is our expectation that the DNR, along with other relevant state agencies, will have the opportunity to review the revised plan prior to finalization.
