Reject the electric bus rebate program. <u>Xcel may offer rebates</u> <u>through this program as long as the funds for the rebates and</u> <u>administration costs are covered by shareholders and/or third-</u> <u>party partners. Xcel does not need to seek approval from the</u> <u>Commission for any rebate program budget or terms given no</u> <u>ratepayer dollars will be used. In any notices or advertisement</u> <u>for such rebates Xcel shall provide notation that no ratepayer</u> <u>dollars are being used to fund them.</u>
