The Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (DNR) has reviewed the recent letter filed by Great River Energy (August 26, 2022) regarding efforts to relocate showy lady's slippers. The letter satisfactorily reflects the DNR's recommendations. However, agency staff would like to clarify one inaccuracy: orchids need a large amount of soil when transplanted because of their relationship with a mycorrhizal fungus, *not an enzyme*.

It is our understanding that potential transplant locations may continue to evolve. The DNR encourages Great River Energy to maintain coordination with our agency's regional ecologist to aid the successful transplant of showy lady's slippers.
